A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to social services; to amend section 68-1206,
Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
provisions relating to eligibility redetermination for a
child care subsidy as prescribed; and to repeal the
original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 68-1206, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 68-1206 (1) The Department of Health and Human Services
- 4 shall administer the program of social services in this state. The
- 5 department may contract with other social agencies for the purchase
- 6 of social services at rates not to exceed those prevailing in the
- 7 state or the cost at which the department could provide those
- 8 services. The statutory maximum payments for the separate program of
- 9 aid to dependent children shall apply only to public assistance
- 10 grants and shall not apply to payments for social services.
- 11 (2) As part of the provision of social services
- 12 <u>authorized by this section and section 68-1202, the department shall</u>
- 13 participate in the federal Child Care Subsidy program. In determining
- 14 ongoing eligibility for this program at redetermination, seven
- 15 percent of a household's gross earned income shall be disregarded
- 16 after twelve months on the program and fifteen percent of a
- 17 household's gross earned income shall be disregarded after twenty-
- 18 four months on the program. After thirty-six months on the program, a
- 19 household's gross income shall be treated the same as at initial
- 20 eligibility for the program.
- 21 $\frac{(2)-(3)}{2}$ In determining the rate or rates to be paid by
- 22 the department for child care as defined in section 43-2605, the
- 23 department shall adopt a fixed-rate schedule for the state or a
- 24 fixed-rate schedule for an area of the state applicable to each child
- 25 care program category of provider as defined in section 71-1910 which

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1 may claim reimbursement for services provided by the federal Child

- 2 Care Subsidy program, except that the department shall not pay a rate
- 3 higher than that charged by an individual provider to that provider's
- 4 private clients. The schedule may provide separate rates for care for
- 5 infants, for children with special needs, including disabilities or
- 6 technological dependence, or for other individual categories of
- 7 children. The schedule shall be effective on October 1 of every year
- 8 and shall be revised annually by the department.

- 10 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
