A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-3,122,
60-3,123, 60-3,124, and 60-3,125, Reissue Revised

Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate the additional fee for
the issuance of Pearl Harbor, prisoner of war, disabled
veteran, and Purple Heart license plates; and to repeal
the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-3,122, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,122 (1) Any person may, in addition to the
- 4 application required by section 60-385, apply to the department for
- 5 license plates designed by the department to indicate that he or she
- 6 is a survivor of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor if he or she:
- 7 (a) Was a member of the United States Armed Forces on
- 8 December 7, 1941;
- 9 (b) Was on station on December 7, 1941, during the hours
- 10 of 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor, the island of
- 11 Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to exceed three miles;
- 12 (c) Was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 13 characterization of honorable from the United States Armed Forces;
- 14 and
- 15 (d) Holds a current membership in a Nebraska Chapter of
- 16 the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association.
- 17 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant
- 18 paying the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars
- 19 and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the
- 20 applicant fulfills the requirements provided by subsection (1) of
- 21 this section. The additional fee shall be remitted to the State
- 22 Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System
- 23 Operation Fund. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers,
- 24 or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any
- 25 one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section

- 1 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 2 (3) If the license plates issued pursuant to this section
- 3 are lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be
- 4 issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 60-3,123, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 6 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 7 60-3,123 (1) Any person who was captured and incarcerated
- 8 by an enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with
- 9 such enemy and who was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 10 characterization of honorable from or is currently serving in the
- 11 United States Armed Forces may, in addition to the application
- 12 required in section 60-385, apply to the department for license
- 13 plates designed to indicate that he or she is a former prisoner of
- 14 war.
- 15 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon the applicant
- 16 paying the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars
- 17 and furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the
- 18 applicant was formerly a prisoner of war. The additional fee shall be
- 19 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran
- 20 Cemetery System Operation Fund. Any number of motor vehicles,
- 21 trailers, semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may
- 22 be so licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers
- 23 registered under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 24 (3) If the license plates issued under this section are
- 25 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the license plates shall

1 be issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge.

- 2 Sec. 3. Section 60-3,124, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 4 60-3,124 (1) Any person who is a veteran of the United
- 5 States Armed Forces, who was discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 6 characterization of honorable or general (under honorable
- 7 conditions), and who is classified by the United States Department of
- 8 Veterans Affairs as one hundred percent service-connected disabled
- 9 may, in addition to the application required in section 60-385, apply
- 10 to the Department of Motor Vehicles for license plates designed by
- 11 the department to indicate that the applicant is a disabled veteran.
- 12 The inscription on the license plates shall be D.A.V. immediately
- 13 below the license plate number to indicate that the holder of the
- 14 license plates is a disabled veteran.
- 15 (2) The plates shall be issued upon the applicant paying
- 16 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
- 17 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant is
- 18 a disabled veteran. The additional fee shall be remitted to the State
- 19 Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System
- 20 Operation Fund. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers,
- 21 or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any
- 22 one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered under section
- 23 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 24 (3) If the license plates issued under this section are
- 25 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be

- 1 issued replacement license plates as provided in section 60-3,157.
- 2 Sec. 4. Section 60-3,125, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 4 60-3,125 (1) Any person may, in addition to the
- 5 application required by section 60-385, apply to the department for
- 6 license plates designed by the department to indicate that the
- 7 applicant has received from the federal government an award of a
- 8 Purple Heart. The inscription of the plates shall be designed so as
- 9 to include a facsimile of the award and beneath any numerical
- 10 designation upon the plates pursuant to section 60-370 the words
- 11 Purple Heart separately on one line and the words Combat Wounded on
- 12 the line below.
- 13 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon payment of
- 14 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
- 15 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
- 16 was awarded the Purple Heart. The additional fee shall be remitted to
- 17 the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery
- 18 System Operation Fund. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers,
- 19 semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so
- 20 licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered
- 21 under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 22 (3) If license plates issued pursuant to this section are
- 23 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be
- 24 issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge.
- 25 Sec. 5. Original sections 60-3,122, 60-3,123, 60-3,124,

1 and 60-3,125, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
