A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to elections; to amend section 32-938, Reissue
2	Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 32-941 and
3	32-947, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to
4	prohibit a person from registering to vote and requesting
5	a ballot for early voting on the same day; to harmonize
6	provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
7	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 32-938, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 32-938 (1) A—Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 4 (4) of this section, a registered voter shall be permitted to vote
- 5 early by requesting a ballot for early voting pursuant to section
- 6 32-941 or 32-943.
- 7 (2) Any person excluded from voting under section 32-313
- 8 or 32-314 shall not be allowed to receive a ballot for early voting.
- 9 (3) Any person who fails to register to vote by the voter
- 10 registration deadline shall not be allowed to vote except as provided
- 11 in section 32-940. or 32-941.
- 12 (4) A person shall not be permitted to register to vote
- 13 and to apply for or vote a ballot to vote early on the same day.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 32-941, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 15 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 16 32-941 Any registered voter permitted to vote early
- 17 pursuant to section 32-938 may, not more than one hundred twenty days
- 18 before any election and not later than 4 p.m. on the Wednesday
- 19 preceding the election, request a ballot for the election to be
- 20 mailed to a specific address. A registered voter shall request a
- 21 ballot in writing to the election commissioner or county clerk in the
- 22 county where the registered voter has established his or her home and
- 23 shall indicate his or her residence address, the address to which the
- 24 ballot is to be mailed if different, and his or her political party,
- 25 telephone number if available, and precinct if known. The registered

voter may use the form published by the election commissioner or 1 2 county clerk pursuant to section 32-808. The registered voter shall 3 sign the request. A registered voter may use a facsimile machine for 4 the submission of a request for a ballot. The election commissioner 5 or county clerk shall include mail a registration application with 6 instead of the ballots if the person is not registered. Registration 7 applications shall not be mailed after the third Friday preceding the 8 election. If the person is not registered to vote, the registration 9 application shall be returned not later than the closing of the polls 10 on the day of the election. No ballot issued under this section shall be counted unless such registration application is properly completed 11 12 and processed. 13 3. Section 32-947, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is amended to read: 14 15 32-947 (1) Upon receipt of an application or other 16 request for a ballot to vote early, the election commissioner or county clerk shall determine whether the applicant is a registered 17 18 voter and is entitled to vote as requested. The election commissioner or county clerk shall not deliver an application for a ballot to vote 19 20 early or a ballot, in person or by mail, on the same day on which the 21 applicant registered to vote. If the election commissioner or county 22 clerk determines that the applicant is a registered voter entitled to vote early and the application was received at or before 4 p.m. on 23 the Wednesday preceding the election, the election commissioner or 24 25 county clerk shall deliver a ballot to the applicant in person or by

1 mail, postage paid. The election commissioner or county clerk or any

- 2 employee of the election commissioner or county clerk shall write or
- 3 cause to be affixed his or her customary signature or initials on the
- 4 ballot.
- 5 (2) An unsealed identification envelope shall be
- 6 delivered with the ballot, and upon the back of the envelope shall be
- 7 printed a form substantially as follows:
- 8 VOTER'S OATH
- 9 I, the undersigned voter, declare that the enclosed
- 10 ballot or ballots contained no voting marks of any kind when I
- 11 received them, and I caused the ballot or ballots to be marked,
- 12 enclosed in the identification envelope, and sealed in such envelope.
- To the best of my knowledge and belief, I declare under
- 14 penalty of election falsification that:
- 15 (a) I,, am a registered voter
- 16 in County;
- 17 (b) I reside in the State of Nebraska
- 18 at;
- 19 (c) I have voted the enclosed ballot and am returning it
- 20 in compliance with Nebraska law; and
- 21 (d) I have not voted and will not vote in this election
- 22 except by this ballot.
- 23 ANY PERSON WHO SIGNS THIS FORM KNOWING THAT ANY OF THE
- 24 INFORMATION IN THE FORM IS FALSE SHALL BE GUILTY OF ELECTION
- 25 FALSIFICATION, A CLASS IV FELONY UNDER SECTION 32-1502 OF THE

1 STATUTES OF NEBRASKA. THE PENALTY FOR ELECTION FALSIFICATION IS

- 2 IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO FIVE YEARS OR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TEN
- 3 THOUSAND DOLLARS, OR BOTH.
- 4 I also understand that failure to sign below will
- 5 invalidate my ballot.
- 6 Signature
- 7 The primary election ballot, if any, within this envelope
- 8 is a primary election ballot of the party.
- 9 Ballots contained in this envelope are for the
- 10 (primary, general, or special) election to be held on the day
- 11 of 20...
- 12 (3) If the ballot and identification envelope will be
- 13 returned by mail or by someone other than the voter, the election
- 14 commissioner or county clerk shall include with the ballot an
- 15 identification envelope upon the face of which shall be printed the
- 16 official title and post office address of the election commissioner
- 17 or county clerk.
- 18 (4) The election commissioner or county clerk shall also
- 19 enclose with the ballot materials: (a) A registration application, if
- 20 the election commissioner or county clerk has determined that the
- 21 applicant is not a registered voter pursuant to section 32-945, with
- 22 instructions that failure to return the completed and signed
- 23 application indicating the residence address as it appears on the
- 24 voter's request for a ballot to the election commissioner or county
- 25 clerk by the close of the polls on election day will result in the

1 ballot not being counted; (b) A registration application and the oath 2 pursuant to section 32-946, if the voter is without a residence 3 address, with instructions that the residence address of the voter 4 shall be deemed that of the office of the election commissioner or 5 county clerk of the county of the voter's prior residence and that 6 failure to return the completed and signed application and oath to 7 the election commissioner or county clerk by the close of the polls 8 on election day will result in the ballot not being counted; or (c) 9 Written written instructions directing the voter to submit a copy of 10 an identification document pursuant to section 32-318.01 if the voter is required to present identification under such section and advising 11 12 the voter that failure to submit identification to the election 13 commissioner or county clerk by the close of the polls on election day will result in the ballot not being counted. 14 15 (5) The election commissioner or county clerk may enclose 16 with the ballot materials a separate return envelope for the voter's use in returning his or her identification envelope containing the 17 voted ballot, registration application, and other materials that may 18 19 be required.

Sec. 4. Original section 32-938, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 32-941 and 32-947, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
