A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-259 and 2-264, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to county agricultural societies; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 2-259, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-259 Pursuant to a request by a county agricultural
- 4 society, the county board of any county may levy an additional levy
- 5 of three and five-tenths cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable
- 6 valuation, or any part thereof, for the purpose of acquiring an
- 7 interest in real property to comprise a portion or all of the county
- 8 fairgrounds, or for the purpose of capital construction on and
- 9 renovation, repair, improvement, and maintenance of the county
- 10 fairgrounds, over and above the operational tax levy authorized in
- 11 section 2-257, or for the purpose of purchasing equipment. Such levy
- 12 shall not exceed the amount actually required for such acquisition or
- work and shall be subject to section 77-3443.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 2-264, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 15 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 16 2-264 A county agricultural society may exchange its real
- 17 estate and improvements for other real estate or to-may sell its real
- 18 estate, for the purpose of acquiring other real estate for
- 19 fairgrounds, and may make, execute, deliver, and accept all proper or
- 20 necessary conveyances in and about such exchange, sale, or purchase,
- 21 and the right of the county in the original grounds and improvements
- 22 as provided for in section 2-263 shall extend to the real estate
- 23 derived from exchange or purchase.
- 24 A county agricultural society may purchase real estate
- 25 and improve the same. The payment of the purchase price may be

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- 1 secured by mortgage or deed of trust.
