Section 1. Section 44-3524, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 44-3524 (1) The director may issue an order and notice of hearing instructing a motor vehicle service contract provider to 4 5 cease and desist from selling or offering for sale motor vehicle service contracts if the director determines that the provider has б 7 comply with the Motor Vehicle Service Contract failed to 8 Reimbursement Insurance Act. At the same time the order is issued, 9 the director shall serve notice to the motor vehicle service provider 10 of the reasons for such order and that the motor vehicle service provider may request a hearing in writing within ten business days 11 12 after receipt of the order. If a hearing is requested, the director 13 shall schedule a hearing within ten business days after receipt of the request. The hearing shall be conducted in accordance with the 14 Administrative Procedure Act. If a hearing is not requested and none 15 16 is ordered by the director, the order shall remain in effect until modified or vacated by the director. 17

18 (2) Upon the failure of a motor vehicle service contract 19 provider to obey a cease and desist order issued by the director, the 20 director may give notice in writing of the failure to the Attorney 21 General who may commence an action against the provider to enjoin the 22 provider from selling or offering for sale motor vehicle service 23 contracts until the provider complies with the act. The district 24 court may issue the injunction.
