A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to public health; to prohibit the use of
Bisphenol A or similar substances in food or beverage
containers or packaging and to require labeling of food
or beverage containers or packaging containing Bisphenol
A as prescribed; to define terms; and to provide a civil
penalty.

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Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:

2 (a) Children means natural persons twelve years of age or 3 younger; 4 (b) Food packaging means a container or wrapper intended 5 for food contact used to store food and foodstuffs for sale; and 6 (c) Reusable food or beverage container means a 7 receptacle for storing food or beverages, including, but not limited 8 to, spill-proof cups, sports bottles, and thermoses. The term does 9 not include food or beverage containers intended for disposal after 10 initial usage. (2) Beginning January 1, 2015, no person or entity shall 11 12 manufacture, sell, or distribute in commerce in this state any 13 reusable food or beverage container containing Bisphenol A. 14 (3) Beginning January 1, 2016, no person or entity shall

(4) No person or entity manufacturing any reusable food or beverage container or food packaging shall replace Bisphenol A with any substance containing carcinogens rated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency as Group A, B, or C carcinogens or substances listed on the agency's Office of Pesticide Programs List of Chemicals Evaluated for Carcinogenic Potential as known or likely carcinogens, known to be human carcinogens, likely to be human

(5) No person or entity manufacturing any reusable food 1 2 or beverage container or food packaging shall replace Bisphenol A 3 with any substance containing reproductive toxicants that the United 4 States Environmental Protection Agency has identified as causing 5 birth defects, reproductive harm, or developmental harm. 6 (6) Beginning January 1, 2016, all food packaging that 7 contains Bisphenol A shall display a label on the front of the 8 package stating: This package contains Bisphenol A, a chemical that 9 may harm fetal development, which can leach into the food. 10 (7) This section shall be enforced by the Department of Environmental Quality. Any person violating this section shall be 11 12 subject to a civil penalty of ten thousand dollars. Any civil penalty 13 assessed and unpaid shall constitute a debt to the state which may be collected in the manner of a lien foreclosure or sued for and 14 recovered in a proper form of action in the name of the state in the 15 16 district court of the county in which the violator resides or owns property. An action to collect a civil penalty shall be brought 17 18 within two years of the alleged violation providing the basis of the penalty, except that if the cause of action is not discovered and 19 20 could not be reasonably discovered within the two-year period, the 21 action may be commenced within two years after the date of discovery 22 or after the date of discovery of facts which would reasonably lead to discovery, whichever is earlier. The department shall remit the 23

civil penalty to the State Treasurer, within thirty days after

receipt, for distribution in accordance with Article VII, section 5,

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1 of the Constitution of Nebraska.
