1 Section 1. Section 83-1217.01, Reissue Revised Statutes

- 2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 83-1217.01 Employees (1) Each employee of state-operated
- 4 services and facilities providing developmental disabilities services
- 5 shall be subject to the criminal history record information check
- 6 requirements of subdivision (9) of section 83-1217 and section
- 7 83-1217.02. file a complete set of his or her legible fingerprints
- 8 with the department. The department shall transmit such fingerprints
- 9 to the Nebraska State Patrol which shall transmit a copy of the
- 10 applicant's fingerprints to the Identification Division of the
- 11 Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history
- 12 <u>record information check.</u>
- 13 (2) The national criminal history record information
- 14 check shall include information concerning the employee from federal
- 15 repositories of such information and repositories of such information
- 16 in other states if authorized by federal law for use by the
- department.
- 18 (3) The Nebraska State Patrol shall undertake a search
- 19 for Nebraska criminal history record information concerning the
- 20 employee. The Nebraska State Patrol shall issue a report to the
- 21 department which contains the results of the criminal history record
- 22 information check conducted by the Nebraska State Patrol.
- 23 <u>(4) Criminal history record information subject to</u>
- 24 <u>federal confidentiality requirements shall remain confidential and</u>
- 25 may be released only upon the written authorization of the employee.
