- FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to amend section 81-132,
 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to require
 a report from state agencies on inefficient programs as
- 4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-132, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 81-132 (1) All departments, offices, and institutions of
- 4 the state government requesting appropriations shall file in the
- 5 office of the Director of Administrative Services the budget forms
- 6 furnished them by the director under the provisions of sections
- 7 81-1113 and 81-1113.01. The budget forms required by this section
- 8 shall be filed on or before September 15 of each even-numbered year,
- 9 except that in 2002, the budget administrator of the budget division
- 10 of the Department of Administrative Services may extend the filing
- 11 deadline for budget forms to a date no later than October 15, 2002.
- 12 The forms shall show their total estimated requirements for the next
- 13 biennium for each unit of their organization and activity classified
- 14 as to object of expenditure. With such forms, each department,
- 15 office, institution, and expending agency shall file a report showing
- 16 all money received by such department, office, institution, or
- 17 expending agency together with the estimated receipts for the coming
- 18 biennium. Such estimates shall be accompanied by a statement in
- 19 writing giving facts and explanations of reasons for each item of
- 20 increased appropriation requested. The report submitted by the
- 21 Department of Health and Human Services shall include, but not be
- 22 limited to, the key goals, benchmarks, and progress reports required
- 23 pursuant to section 81-3133.
- 24 (2) Along with the forms and report required under
- 25 <u>subsection (1) of this section, each department, office, institution,</u>

- 1 and expending agency shall file a report identifying low-utilization,
- 2 low-priority, and inefficient programs that are required by statute
- 3 and are under the jurisdiction of such department, office,
- 4 <u>institution</u>, or <u>expending agency</u>. The report shall include
- 5 recommendations for improvement or elimination of such programs.
