## A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the One-Call Notification System Act; to amend
section 76-2325, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
and section 76-2301, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013;
to change penalties; to authorize injunctions; and to
repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 76-2301, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2013, is amended to read:
- 3 76-2301 Sections 76-2301 to 76-2330 <u>and section 3 of this</u>
- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the One-Call Notification
- 5 System Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 76-2325, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 76-2325 (1) Any person who violates the provisions of
- 9 section 76-2320, 76-2321, 76-2322, 76-2323, 76-2326, or 76-2330 shall
- 10 be subject to a civil penalty as follows:
- 11 (1)—(a) For a violation related to a gas or hazardous
- 12 liquid underground pipeline facility, an amount not to exceed ten
- 13 thousand dollars for each violation for each day the violation
- 14 persists, up to a maximum of five hundred thousand dollars; and
- 15 (2) (b) For a violation related to any other underground
- 16 facility, an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars for each day
- 17 the violation persists, up to a maximum of <u>five-ten</u>thousand dollars.
- 18 (2) An action to recover a civil penalty shall be brought
- 19 by the Attorney General or a prosecuting attorney on behalf of the
- 20 State of Nebraska in any court of competent jurisdiction of this
- 21 state. The trial shall be before the court, which shall consider the
- 22 nature, circumstances, and gravity of the violation and, with respect
- 23 to the person found to have committed the violation, the degree of
- 24 culpability, the absence or existence of prior violations, whether
- 25 the violation was a willful act, any good faith attempt to achieve

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1 compliance, and such other matters as justice may require in

- 2 determining the amount of penalty imposed. All penalties shall be
- 3 handled and distributed pursuant to Article VII, section 5, of the
- 4 Constitution of Nebraska.
- Sec. 3. Whenever it appears that an excavator has
- 6 repeatedly violated any provision of the One-Call Notification Act or
- 7 <u>is violating or is threatening to violate any provision of the act,</u>
- 8 <u>an operator of an underground facility may institute a civil suit for</u>
- 9 <u>injunctive relief to restrain the excavator from continuing the</u>
- 10 <u>violation or threat of violation.</u>
