Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB801

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 801 establishes a procedure for a property owner or occupant to appeal a nuisance citation in a city of the first class, city of the second class, or a village. Current law allows an appeal but does not specify the appeal procedure. Last year the legislature enacted LB 643 which established an appeal procedure for grass (weeds), and litter nuisance citations. LB 801 would extend the same appeal procedure to other nuisance citations.
