## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Sec. 1. clarifies that under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act, shoulder injuries would not be compensated pursuant to the loss schedule for arm injuries (48-121). Instead, shoulder injuries would be considered as injuries to the body as a whole and compensated pursuant to loss of earning capacity.
