## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 807 amends section 23-1201. Currently, section 23-1201 requires county attorneys make a quarterly report to the county board on the final disposition of criminal case from the previous quarter, criminal cases pending at the end of the quarter, and criminal case appealed during the quarter. The statute currently allows county boards in counties with a population of less than two hundred thousand to waive this report.

This bill would grant all county boards the authority to waive the report, regardless of population level.
