Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 808 would change the process for amending an economic development program under the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act, commonly referred to as LB 840.

Under the bill, a municipality could amend an existing LB 840 plan to add or remove a type of qualifying business if such addition or removal is recommended by its citizen advisory review committee. Amendment of an LB 840 plan would require a two-thirds vote of the municipality's governing body.
