Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB901 amends the Dentistry Practice Act to expand the scope of practice of dental assistants and hygienists in accordance with a credentialing review (407 process) completed by the Department of Health and Human Services. Creates a new license for dental assistants, while allowing unlicensed dental assistants to remain in practice for limited duties. Creates new requirements and permits for expanded function dental assistants and expanded function dental hygienists who have completed certain education and training requirements. Allows the Board of Dentistry to approve the education and training requirements and issue such licenses and permits.

Explanation of amendments:

AM2024 changes "general" to "indirect" supervision of a dental assistant by a dentist to perform x-rays and coronal polishing as requested at the hearing by the dental hygienists association.
