- 5 the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) Flying lantern-type devices are prohibited from sale,
- 7 possession, and use in this state.
- 8 (2) For purposes of this section, flying lantern-type devices means
- 9 devices that require a flame which produces heated air trapped in a
- 10 balloon-type covering allowing the device to float in the air. Flying
- 11 <u>lantern-type devices shall not include hot-air balloons used for</u>
- 12 <u>transporting persons.</u>
- 13 (3) A violation of this section is a Class V misdemeanor.
- 14 Sec. 3. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015,
- 15 is repealed.
- 16 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 17 passed and approved according to law.
