- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Dry Bean Resources Act; to amend sections 2-3753, 2-3755, 2-3762, and 2-3763, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to expenditures for lobbying activities, fees, annual reporting requirements, and credit of funds; to eliminate a refund; to repeal the original sections; to outright repeal section 2-3760, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; and to declare an emergency.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 2-3753, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 2-3753 The commission shall have the following powers and duties:
- 4 (1) To adopt and devise a dry bean program consisting of research,
- 5 education, advertising, publicity, and promotion to increase total
- 6 consumption of dry beans on a state, national, and international basis;
- 7 (2) To prepare and approve a budget consistent with limited receipts
- 8 and the scope of the dry bean program;
- 9 (3) To adopt and promulgate reasonable rules and regulations
- 10 necessary to carry out the dry bean program;
- 11 (4) To procure and evaluate data and information necessary for the
- 12 proper administration and operation of the dry bean program;
- 13 (5) To employ personnel and contract for services which are
- 14 necessary for the proper operation of the dry bean program;
- 15 (6) To establish a means whereby the grower and processor of dry
- 16 beans has the opportunity at least annually to offer his or her ideas and
- 17 suggestions relative to commission policy for the coming year;
- 18 (7) To authorize the expenditure of funds and contracting of
- 19 expenditures to conduct proper activities of the program;
- 20 (8) To bond such persons as may be necessary in order to insure
- 21 adequate protection of funds;
- 22 (9) To keep minutes of its meetings and other books and records
- 23 which will clearly reflect all of the acts and transactions of the
- 24 commission and to keep such records open to examination by any grower or
- 25 processor participant during normal business hours;
- 26 (10) To prohibit any funds collected by the commission from being
- 27 expended directly or indirectly to promote or oppose any candidate for
- 28 public office or to influence state legislation. The commission board
- 29 shall not expend more than <u>fifteen</u> twenty-five percent of its annual
- 30 budget to influence federal legislation. The purpose of such expenditures
- 31 for federal lobbying activity shall be limited to activity supporting the

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1 underlying objectives of the dry bean program relating to market

- 2 development, education, and research;
- 3 (11) To establish an administrative office at such place in the
- 4 state as may be suitable for the proper discharge of the functions of the
- 5 commission; and
- 6 (12) To adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the
- 7 Dry Bean Resources Act.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 2-3755, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 2-3755 (1) Beginning August 1, 1987, there shall be paid to the
- 11 commission a fee of six cents per hundredweight upon all dry beans grown
- 12 in the state during 1987 and thereafter and sold through commercial
- 13 channels. Beginning January 1, 1989, until July 31, 2015, the commission
- 14 may, whenever it determines that the fees provided by this section are
- 15 yielding more or less than is required to carry out the intent and
- 16 purposes of the Dry Bean Resources Act, reduce or increase such fee for
- 17 such period as it shall deem justifiable, but not less than one year and
- 18 not to exceed ten cents per hundredweight.
- 19 (2) Beginning August 1, 2015, the fee imposed by this section shall
- 20 <u>be fifteen cents per hundredweight. Beginning January 1, 2017, the</u>
- 21 commission may, whenever it determines that the fees provided by this
- 22 section are yielding more or less than is required to carry out the
- 23 intent and purposes of the act, reduce or increase such fee for such
- 24 period as it shall deem justifiable, but not less than one year and not
- 25 to exceed twenty-four cents per hundredweight.
- 26 (3) Two-thirds of the fee levied under this section shall be paid by
- 27 the grower at the time of sale or delivery and shall be collected by the
- 28 first purchaser. The first purchaser shall pay the remaining one-third of
- 29 the fee. No dry beans shall be subject to the fee more than once.
- 30 Sec. 3. Section 2-3762, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 31 amended to read:

- 1 2-3762 (1) The commission shall prepare and make available make and
- 2 publish an annual report at least thirty days prior to January 1 of each
- 3 year which shall set forth in detail the income received from the dry
- 4 bean assessment for the previous year and shall include:
- 5 (a \pm) The expenditure of all funds by the commission during the
- 6 previous year for the administration of the Dry Bean Resources Act;
- 7 $(\underline{b} \ 2)$ The action taken by the commission on all contracts requiring
- 8 the expenditure of funds by the commission;
- 9 (c) A description (3) Copies of all such contracts;
- 10 $(\underline{d} + \underline{d})$ Detailed explanation of all programs relating to the
- 11 discovery, promotion, and development of bean products and industries for
- 12 the utilization of dry beans, the direct expense associated with each
- 13 program, and copies of such programs if in writing; and
- 14 $(\underline{e} \ 5)$ The name and address of each member of the commission and a
- 15 copy of all rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the
- 16 commission.
- 17 <u>(2)</u> The report <u>and a copy of all contracts requiring expenditure of</u>
- 18 <u>funds by the commission</u> shall be available to the public upon request.
- 19 Notice of availability of such report shall be provided to the Director
- 20 of Agriculture, the Clerk of the Legislature, and a summary of such
- 21 report shall be sent to each grower and first purchaser subject to the
- 22 checkoff.
- 23 Sec. 4. Section 2-3763, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 24 amended to read:
- 25 2-3763 The State Treasurer shall establish in the treasury of the
- 26 State of Nebraska a fund to be known as the Dry Bean Development,
- 27 Utilization, Promotion, and Education Fund, to which fund shall be
- 28 credited funds collected by the commission pursuant to the Dry Bean
- 29 Resources Act, including license fees, royalties, or any repayments
- 30 relating to the fund. The fund shall be expended for the administration
- 31 of such act. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be

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1 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital

- 2 Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 3 Sec. 5. Original sections 2-3753, 2-3755, 2-3762, and 2-3763,
- 4 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 5 Sec. 6. The following section is outright repealed: Section 2-3760,
- 6 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 7 Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 8 passed and approved according to law.
