- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Registration Act; to
- 2 amend section 60-3,100, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to
- 3 provide for issuance of one license plate for passenger cars as
- 4 prescribed; to provide a fee; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
- 5 the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-3,100, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 60-3,100 (1) The department shall issue to every person whose motor
- 4 vehicle or trailer is registered one or two fully reflectorized license
- 5 plates upon which shall be displayed (a) the registration number
- 6 consisting of letters and numerals assigned to such motor vehicle or
- 7 trailer in figures not less than two and one-half inches nor more than
- 8 three inches in height and (b) also the word Nebraska suitably lettered
- 9 so as to be attractive. Two license plates shall be issued for every
- 10 motor vehicle, except that one plate shall be issued for dealers,
- 11 autocycles, motorcycles, minitrucks, truck-tractors, trailers, buses,
- 12 apportionable vehicles, and special interest motor vehicles that use the
- 13 special interest motor vehicle license plate authorized by and issued
- 14 under section 60-3,135.01. The license plates shall be of a color
- 15 designated by the director. The color of the plates shall be changed each
- 16 time the license plates are changed. Each time the license plates are
- 17 changed, the director shall secure competitive bids for materials
- 18 pursuant to sections 81-145 to 81-162. Autocycle, motorcycle, minitruck,
- 19 low-speed vehicle, and trailer license plate letters and numerals may be
- 20 one-half the size of those required in this section.
- 21 (2)(a) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, two license
- 22 plates shall be issued for every motor vehicle.
- 23 (b) One license plate shall be issued for (i) apportionable
- 24 vehicles, (ii) buses, (iii) dealers, (iv) minitrucks, (v) motorcycles,
- 25 (vi) special interest motor vehicles that use the special interest motor
- 26 <u>vehicle license plate authorized by and issued under section 60-3,135.01,</u>
- 27 (vii) trailers, and (viii) truck-tractors.
- (c)(i) Beginning January 1, 2017, one license plate shall be issued,
- 29 upon request and compliance with this subdivision, for any passenger car
- 30 which is not manufactured to be equipped with a bracket on the front of
- 31 the vehicle to display a license plate. A license decal shall be issued

- 1 with the license plate as provided in subdivision (ii) of this
- 2 <u>subdivision</u> and shall be displayed on the driver's side of the
- 3 windshield. In order to request a single license plate and license decal,
- 4 there shall be an additional annual nonrefundable registration fee of one
- 5 hundred dollars plus the cost of the decal paid to the county treasurer
- 6 at the time of registration. All fees collected under this subdivision
- 7 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Highway Trust
- 8 Fund.
- 9 (ii) The department shall design, procure, and furnish to the county
- 10 treasurers a license decal which shall be displayed as evidence that a
- 11 <u>license plate has been obtained under this subdivision. Each county</u>
- 12 <u>treasurer shall furnish a license decal to the person obtaining the</u>
- 13 plate.
- 14 $(\underline{d} \ 2)$ When two license plates are issued, one shall be prominently
- 15 displayed at all times on the front and one on the rear of the registered
- 16 motor vehicle or trailer. When only one plate is issued, it shall be
- 17 prominently displayed on the rear of the registered motor vehicle or
- 18 trailer. When only one plate is issued for motor vehicles registered
- 19 pursuant to section 60-3,198 and truck-tractors, it shall be prominently
- 20 displayed on the front of the apportionable vehicle.
