- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated (1) \$191,200 from the</u>
2	General Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$249,950 from the General Fund for
3	FY2017-18 to the Supreme Court, for Program 420, to aid in carrying out
4	the provisions of Legislative Bill 919, One Hundred Fourth Legislature,
5	Second Session, 2016.
6	Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
7	diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$60,953
8	<u>for FY2016-17 or \$81,270 for FY2017-18.</u>
9	Sec. 2. <u>There is hereby appropriated (1) \$10,000 from the Supreme</u>
10	Court Automation Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$10,000 from the Supreme
11	Court Automation Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Supreme Court, for
12	Program 570, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
13	919, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.
14	No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
15	for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
16	section.
17	Sec. 3. <u>It is the intent of the Legislature that funds appropriated</u>
18	in this act be used by the Supreme Court to create a veterans treatment
19	court for any county in which a city of the metropolitan class is
20	located. Such court shall be considered a problem solving court and shall
21	be subject to the rules which shall be promulgated by the Supreme Court
22	for procedures to be implemented for the administration of such court.
23	By December 1, 2019, the Supreme Court shall report the viability of
24	the veterans treatment court model in Nebraska and electronically submit
25	<u>a report to the Legislature containing the Supreme Court's</u>
26	recommendations concerning the continuation, expansion, or termination of
27	<u>such courts in Nebraska.</u>
