- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to community colleges; to amend sections 85-1517 and 85-2234, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to reduce the levy authority of community college areas as prescribed; to
- 4 increase the amount of state aid to community colleges under the
- 5 Community College Aid Act; to repeal the original sections; and to
- 6 declare an emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 85-1517, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 85-1517 (1) For fiscal years 2011-12 and 2012-13:
- 4 (a) The board may certify to the county board of equalization of
- 5 each county within the community college area a tax levy not to exceed
- 6 ten and one-quarter cents on each one hundred dollars on the taxable
- 7 valuation of all property subject to the levy within the community
- 8 college area, uniform throughout the area, for the purpose of supporting
- 9 operating expenditures of the community college area;
- 10 (b) In addition to the levies provided in subdivisions (1)(a) and
- 11 (c) of this section, the board may certify to the county board of
- 12 equalization of each county within the community college area a tax levy
- 13 not to exceed one cent on each one hundred dollars on the taxable
- 14 valuation of all property within the community college area, uniform
- 15 throughout such area, for the purposes of paying off bonds issued under
- 16 sections 85-1520 to 85-1527 and establishing a capital improvement and
- 17 bond sinking fund as provided in section 85-1515. The levy provided by
- 18 this subdivision may be exceeded by that amount necessary to retire the
- 19 general obligation bonds assumed by the community college area or issued
- 20 pursuant to section 85-1515 according to the terms of such bonds or for
- 21 any obligation pursuant to section 85-1535 entered into prior to January
- 22 1, 1997; and
- 23 (c) In addition to the levies provided in subdivisions (1)(a) and
- 24 (b) of this section, the board may also certify to the county board of
- 25 equalization of each county within the community college area a tax levy
- 26 on each one hundred dollars on the taxable valuation of all property
- 27 within the community college area, uniform throughout such area, in the
- 28 amount which will produce funds only in the amount necessary to pay for
- 29 funding accessibility barrier elimination project costs and abatement of
- 30 environmental hazards as such terms are defined in section 79-10,110.
- 31 Such tax levy shall not be so certified unless approved by an affirmative

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- 1 vote of a majority of the board taken at a public meeting of the board
- following notice and a hearing. The board shall give at least seven days' 2
- notice of such public hearing and shall publish such notice once in a 3
- 4 newspaper of general circulation in the area to be affected by the
- 5 increase. The proceeds of such tax levy shall be deposited in the capital
- 6 improvement and bond sinking fund provided for in section 85-1515 for use
- 7 in funding the projects authorized pursuant to this subdivision.
- 8 (2) For fiscal year 2013-14 and each fiscal year thereafter:
- 9 (a)(i) The board may certify to the county board of equalization of each county within the community college area a tax levy not to exceed 10 the difference between eleven and one-quarter cents, as such amount is 11 adjusted pursuant to subdivision (2)(a)(ii) of this section, and the rate 12 levied for such fiscal year pursuant to subdivision (b) of this 13 14 subsection on each one hundred dollars on the taxable valuation of all property subject to the levy within the community college area, uniform 15 16 throughout the area, for the purpose of supporting operating expenditures of the community college area. For purposes of calculating the amount of 17 levy authority available for operating expenditures pursuant to this 18 19 subdivision, the rate levied pursuant to subdivision (b) of this subsection shall not include amounts to retire general obligation bonds 20 assumed by the community college area or issued pursuant to section 21 85-1515 according to the terms of such bonds or for any obligation 22
- 24 (ii) The eleven and one-quarter cent amount provided in subdivision (2)(a)(i) of this section shall be reduced to ten and one-quarter cents 25 for fiscal year 2015-16, nine and one-quarter cents for fiscal year 26 2016-17, eight and one-quarter cents for fiscal year 2017-18, seven and 27 one-quarter cents for fiscal year 2018-19, and six and one-quarter cents 28 for fiscal year 2019-20 and each fiscal year thereafter;

pursuant to section 85-1535 entered into prior to January 1, 1997.  $\div$ 

(b) In addition to the levies provided in subdivisions (2)(a) and 30 31 (2)(c) of this section subsection, the board may certify to the county

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1 board of equalization of each county within the community college area a 2 tax levy not to exceed two cents on each one hundred dollars on the taxable valuation of all property within the community college area, 3 4 uniform throughout such area, for the purposes of paying off bonds issued 5 under sections 85-1520 to 85-1527 and establishing a capital improvement and bond sinking fund as provided in section 85-1515. The levy provided 6 7 by this subdivision may be exceeded by that amount necessary to retire general obligation bonds assumed by the community college area or issued 8 9 pursuant to section 85-1515 according to the terms of such bonds or for any obligation pursuant to section 85-1535 entered into prior to January 10 1, 1997; and 11

(c) In addition to the levies provided in subdivisions (2)(a) and 12 13 (2)(b) of this <u>section</u> subsection, the board of a community college area with a campus located on the site of a former ammunition depot may 14 certify to the county board of equalization of each county within the 15 16 community college area a tax levy not to exceed three-quarters of one 17 cent on each one hundred dollars on the taxable valuation of all property within the community college area, uniform throughout such area, to pay 18 19 for funding accessibility barrier elimination project costs and abatement of environmental hazards as such terms are defined in section 79-10,110. 20 Such tax levy shall not be so certified unless approved by an affirmative 21 vote of a majority of the board taken at a public meeting of the board 22 23 following notice and a hearing. The board shall give at least seven days' 24 notice of such public hearing and shall publish such notice once in a 25 newspaper of general circulation in the area to be affected by the increase. The proceeds of such tax levy shall be deposited in the capital 26 improvement and bond sinking fund provided for in section 85-1515 for use 27 28 in funding accessibility barrier elimination project costs and abatement of environmental hazards as such terms are defined in section 79-10,110. 29

(3) The taxes provided by this section shall be levied and assessed in the same manner as other property taxes and entered on the books of

- 1 the county treasurer. The proceeds of the tax, as collected, shall be
- 2 remitted to the treasurer of the board not less frequently than once each
- 3 month.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 85-2234, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 5 amended to read:
- 6 85-2234 Aid appropriated pursuant to the Community College Aid Act
- 7 for fiscal year 2013-14 and each fiscal year thereafter shall be
- 8 allocated among community college areas and tribally controlled community
- 9 colleges as follows:
- 10 (1) The initial \$XXX \$87,870,147 appropriated pursuant to the act
- 11 shall be allocated to community college areas based on the proportionate
- 12 share of aid received by each community college area for fiscal year
- 13 2012-13. If the amount appropriated for such fiscal year exceeds <u>\$XXX</u>
- 14 \$87,870,147, the excess amount shall be allocated as provided in
- 15 subdivisions (2) and (3) of this section. If the amount appropriated for
- 16 such fiscal year is less than or equal to \$XXX \$87,870,147, the amount
- 17 appropriated shall be allocated to community college areas based on the
- 18 proportionate share of aid received by each community college area for
- 19 fiscal year 2012-13;
- 20 (2) Of any amount remaining after the allocation of aid pursuant to
- 21 subdivision (1) of this section, the next amount, up to but not to exceed
- 22 \$500,000, shall be allocated as state aid pursuant to section 85-1539;
- 23 and
- 24 (3) Any amount remaining after the allocations provided for in
- 25 subdivisions (1) and (2) of this section shall be allocated among the
- 26 community college areas on the following basis:
- 27 (a) Twenty-five percent of such amount shall be divided equally
- 28 based on the number of community college areas designated pursuant to
- 29 section 85-1504;
- 30 (b) Forty-five percent of such amount shall be divided based on each
- 31 community college area's proportionate share of three-year average full-

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- 1 time equivalent student enrollment. A community college area's
- 2 proportionate share of three-year average full-time equivalent student
- 3 enrollment shall equal the sum of a community college area's full-time
- 4 equivalent student enrollment total for the three fiscal years
- 5 immediately preceding the fiscal year for which aid is being calculated
- 6 divided by three, with such quotient divided by the quotient resulting
- 7 from the sum of the full-time equivalent student enrollment total of all
- 8 community college areas for the three fiscal years immediately preceding
- 9 the fiscal year for which aid is being calculated divided by three; and
- 10 (c) Thirty percent of such amount shall be divided based on each
- 11 community college area's proportionate share of three-year average
- 12 reimbursable educational units. A community college area's proportionate
- 13 share of three-year average reimbursable educational units shall equal
- 14 the sum of a community college area's reimbursable educational unit total
- 15 for the three fiscal years immediately preceding the fiscal year for
- 16 which aid is being calculated divided by three, with such quotient
- 17 divided by the quotient resulting from the sum of the reimbursable
- 18 educational unit total of all community college areas for the three
- 19 fiscal years immediately preceding the fiscal year for which aid is being
- 20 calculated divided by three.
- 21 Sec. 3. Original sections 85-1517 and 85-2234, Reissue Revised
- 22 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 24 passed and approved according to law.
