- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to amend sections 79-1191,
- 2 79-1194, and 79-1196, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change provisions relating to appropriations for bridge programs; to
- 4 require reports; to change a termination date; and to repeal the
- 5 original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 79-1191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-1191 The Legislature shall appropriate two hundred thousand
- 4 dollars each fiscal year for three consecutive fiscal years beginning
- 5 with FY2012-13 to the department from the Education Innovation Fund to
- 6 provide grants to establish or continue bridge programs. Such programs
- 7 shall:
- 8 (1) Provide English reading and writing and math skills required to
- 9 succeed in a postsecondary educational credentialing or degree program;
- 10 (2) Lead to the attainment of college credit and a recognized
- 11 postsecondary educational credential or an industry-recognized
- 12 credential;
- 13 (3) Be open only to low-income participants who are co-enrolled in
- 14 adult education, developmental education, or English as a second
- 15 language;
- 16 (4) Target the specific workforce needs of an occupational sector
- 17 within the state and provide services aimed at improving education,
- 18 skills, and employment prospects for low-income adults;
- 19 (5) Use educational best practices, including, but not limited to,
- 20 contextualized instructional strategies, team teaching, modularized
- 21 learning, or reduced student-teacher ratios; and
- 22 (6) Provide for supportive services needed for student educational
- 23 and employment success, including, but not limited to, job coaching and
- 24 personal needs.
- 25 Sec. 2. Section 79-1194, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 26 amended to read:
- 27 79-1194 (1) The department may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 28 regulations to carry out sections 79-1189 to 79-1193.
- 29 (2) The department shall annually file a report electronically with
- 30 the Legislature on the bridge programs established pursuant to sections
- 31 79-1189 to 79-1196, using the data provided pursuant to section 79-1193.
