1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 4 section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
- 5 Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) A person commits the offense of rehoming a child if he
- 7 or she is a parent or custodian of a child and engages in: (a) A
- 8 transaction, or any act taken to facilitate such transaction, through
- 9 electronic or any other means, with the intent to leave such child and
- 10 permanently avoid parental responsibility by placing such child in the
- 11 physical custody of a nonrelative without court approval except as
- 12 provided in subsection (2) of this section; (b) the selling,
- 13 <u>transferring</u>, or arranging for the sale or transfer of a child to another
- 14 person or entity for money or anything of value or to receive such child
- 15 for money or anything of value; or (c) assisting, aiding, abetting, or
- 16 conspiring in the commission of any act described in subdivision (a) or
- 17 (b) of this section regardless of whether money or anything of value was
- 18 promised or received by the person.
- 19 (2) Rehoming a child does not include: (a) Placement of a child by a
- 20 parent or custodian with a relative, stepparent, adoption agency, or the
- 21 <u>Division of Children and Family Services of the Department of Health and</u>
- 22 Human Services; (b) temporary placement of a child by a parent or
- 23 custodian for a designated short-term period of time with specific intent
- 24 to return for the child; (c) placement of a child in another state in
- 25 accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Compact on the
- 26 Placement of Children; (d) leaving a child at a hospital as provided in
- 27 <u>section 29-121; or (e) placement pursuant to the Nebraska Indian Child</u>
- 28 Welfare Act, including any adoption under tribal law or custom.
- 29 <u>(3) For the purposes of this section:</u>
- 30 <u>(a) Action includes transferring, recruiting, harboring,</u>
- 31 transporting, providing, soliciting, or obtaining a child; and

- 1 (b) Child means an individual under the age of eighteen years.
- 2 (4) Any person who commits the offense of rehoming a child is guilty
- 3 <u>of a Class IV felony.</u>
