- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to Rural Community-Based Energy Development
- 2 Act; to amend sections 70-1907, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- Nebraska, and 70-1903, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014;
- 4 to redefine a term; to change requirements for project developers;
- 5 and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 70-1903, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 70-1903 For purposes of the Rural Community-Based Energy Development
- 4 Act:
- 5 (1) C-BED project or community-based energy development project
- 6 means a new energy generation project using wind, solar, biomass, or
- 7 landfill gas as the fuel source that:
- 8 (a) Has at least twenty-five percent of the gross power purchase
- 9 agreement payments flowing to the qualified owner or owners or as
- 10 payments to the local community; and
- (b) Has a resolution of support adopted:
- 12 (i) By the county board of each county in which the C-BED project is
- 13 to be located and which has adopted zoning regulations that require
- 14 planning commission, county board, or county commission approval for the
- 15 C-BED project; or
- 16 (ii) By the tribal council for a C-BED project located within the
- 17 boundaries of an Indian reservation;
- 18 (2) Electric utility means an electric supplier that:
- 19 (a) Owns more than one hundred miles of one-hundred-fifteen-kilovolt
- 20 or larger transmission lines in the State of Nebraska;
- 21 (b) Owns more than two hundred megawatts of electric generating
- 22 facilities; and
- (c) Has the obligation to directly serve more than two hundred
- 24 megawatts of wholesale or retail electric load in the State of Nebraska;
- 25 (3) Gross power purchase agreement payments means the total amount
- of payments during the first twenty years of the agreement;
- 27 (4) Payments to the local community include, but are not limited to:
- 28 (a) Lease and easement payments to property owners made as part of a
- 29 C-BED project;
- 30 (b) Contract payments for concrete, steel, gravel, towers, turbines,
- 31 blades, wire, or engineering, procurement, construction, geotechnical,

- 1 environmental, meteorological, or legal services or payments for other
- 2 components, equipment, materials, or services that are necessary to
- 3 permit or construct the C-BED project and that are provided by a company
- 4 that has been organized or incorporated in Nebraska under Nebraska law
- 5 and has employed at least five Nebraska residents for at least eighteen
- 6 months prior to the date of the project application for certification as
- 7 a C-BED project; and
- 8 (c) Payments that are for physical parts, materials, or components
- 9 that are manufactured, assembled, or fabricated in Nebraska and that are
- 10 not described in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subdivision.
- 11 Such payments need not be made directly from power purchase
- 12 agreement revenue and may be made from other funds in advance of
- 13 receiving power purchase agreement revenue; and
- 14 (5) Qualified owner means:
- 15 (a) A Nebraska resident;
- 16 (b) A limited liability company that is organized under the Nebraska
- 17 Uniform Limited Liability Company Act and that is made up of members who
- 18 are Nebraska residents;
- 19 (c) A Nebraska nonprofit corporation organized under the Nebraska
- 20 Nonprofit Corporation Act;
- 21 (d) An electric supplier as defined in section 70-1001.01, except
- 22 that ownership in a single C-BED project is limited to no more than:
- 23 (i) Fifteen percent either directly or indirectly by a single
- 24 electric supplier; and
- 25 (ii) A combined total of twenty-five percent ownership either
- 26 directly or indirectly by multiple electric suppliers;
- 27 (e) A tribal council;
- 28 (f) A domestic corporation organized in Nebraska under the Business
- 29 Corporation Act and domiciled in Nebraska; or
- 30 (g) A cooperative corporation organized under sections 21-1301 to
- 31 21-1306 and domiciled in Nebraska.

- 3 70-1907 To the extent feasible, a C-BED project developer shall
- 4 provide, in writing, <u>notice of incentives pursuant to the Rural</u>
- 5 <u>Community-Based Energy Development Act for local ownership and local</u>
- 6 participation in a C-BED project to each property owner on whose property
- 7 a turbine will be located and to the elected governing body of each
- 8 <u>municipality or political subdivision in which a turbine will be located</u>
- 9 an opportunity to become a qualified owner in the C-BED project to each
- 10 property owner on whose property a turbine will be located.
