**LEGISLATIVE BILL 519A**

Introduced by Sullivan, 41.

Read first time April 21, 2015

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 519, One Hundred
- 3 Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$10,080,146 from the  
2 Nebraska Opportunity Grant Fund for FY2016-17 to the Coordinating  
3 Commission for Postsecondary Education, for Program 690, to aid in  
4 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 519, One Hundred Fourth  
5 Legislature, First Session, 2015.

6           There is included in the amount shown for this program \$10,080,146  
7 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2016-17 to provide student  
8 financial aid under the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Act.

9           Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated \$1,463,247 from the Community  
10 College Gap Assistance Program Fund for FY2016-17 to the Coordinating  
11 Commission for Postsecondary Education, for Program 692, to aid in  
12 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 519, One Hundred Fourth  
13 Legislature, First Session, 2015.

14           Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per  
15 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$60,000  
16 for FY2016-17.

17           There is included in the amount shown for this program \$1,390,085  
18 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2016-17 to provide community  
19 college gap assistance.

20           Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated \$3,251,660 from the Department  
21 of Education Innovative Grant Fund for FY2016-17 to the State Department  
22 of Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of  
23 Legislative Bill 519, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,  
24 2015.

25           Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per  
26 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$70,802  
27 for FY2016-17.

28           There is included in the amount shown for this program \$3,122,800  
29 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2016-17 to provide competitive  
30 innovation grants.

31           Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated \$1,300,664 from the Excellence

1 in Teaching Cash Fund for FY2016-17 to the State Department of Education,  
2 for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative  
3 Bill 519, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

4 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per  
5 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$40,397  
6 for FY2016-17.

7 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$1,235,631  
8 Cash Funds provided as state aid for FY2016-17 to provide assistance to  
9 students under the Excellence in Teaching Act.

10 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated \$162,583 from the Expanded  
11 Learning Opportunity Grant Fund for FY2016-17 to the State Department of  
12 Education, for Program 161, to aid in carrying out the provisions of  
13 Legislative Bill 519, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,  
14 2015.

15 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems  
16 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this  
17 section.

18 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$159,453 Cash  
19 Funds provided as state aid for FY2016-17 to provide expanded learning  
20 opportunity grants.
