- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Pure Food Act; to amend section 81-2,245.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 redefine a term; to provide an exception for certain operations
- 4 preparing food for indirect sale to a consumer as prescribed; to
- 5 provide a duty for the Department of Agriculture; and to repeal the
- 6 original section.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 81-2,245.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 81-2,245.01 Food establishment shall mean an operation that stores,
- 4 prepares, packages, serves, sells, vends, or otherwise provides food for
- 5 human consumption. The term does not include:
- 6 (1) An establishment or vending machine operation that offers only
- 7 prepackaged soft drinks, carbonated or noncarbonated; canned or bottled
- 8 fruit and vegetable juices; prepackaged ice; candy; chewing gum; potato
- 9 or corn chips; pretzels; cheese puffs and curls; crackers; popped
- 10 popcorn; nuts and edible seeds; and cookies, cakes, pies, and other
- 11 pastries, that are not potentially hazardous foods;
- 12 (2) A produce stand that only offers whole, uncut fresh fruits and
- 13 vegetables;
- 14 (3) A food processing plant;
- 15 (4) A salvage operation;
- 16 (5) A private home where food is prepared or served for personal
- 17 use, a small day care in the home, or a hunting lodge, guest ranch, or
- 18 other operation where no more than ten paying guests eat meals in the
- 19 home;
- 20 (6) A private home or other area where food that is not potentially
- 21 hazardous food is prepared:
- 22 (a) For sale or service at a religious, charitable, or fraternal
- 23 organization's bake sale or similar function;—or
- 24 (b) For for sale directly to the consumer at a farmer's farmers
- 25 market if the consumer is informed by a clearly visible placard at the
- 26 sale location that the food was prepared in a kitchen that is not subject
- 27 to regulation and inspection by the regulatory authority; or
- 28 (c) For sale indirectly to a consumer through a third-party food
- 29 <u>establishment if:</u>
- 30 (i) The operation has registered with the department and complied
- 31 with any applicable food safety requirements;

- 1 (ii) The consumer is informed by a clearly visible placard at the
- 2 <u>sale location or on the package or container label that the food was</u>
- 3 prepared in a kitchen that is not subject to regulation and inspection by
- 4 the regulatory authority;
- 5 (iii) The operation has not more than fifty thousand dollars in
- 6 gross annual sales during a calendar year;
- 7 (iv) The operation does not employ more than one full-time
- 8 equivalent employee, not including a family member or a member of the
- 9 operator's household; and
- 10 (v) The owner of the operation and his or her employees have
- 11 undergone food handler training provided online on the department's web
- 12 <u>site. The department shall develop and make available an online food</u>
- 13 handler training program on its web site not later than December 31,
- 14 <u>2015;</u>
- 15 (7) A private home or other area where food is prepared for
- 16 distribution at a fundraising event for a charitable purpose if the
- 17 consumer is informed by a clearly visible placard at the serving location
- 18 that the food was prepared in a kitchen that is not subject to regulation
- 19 and inspection by the regulatory authority. This subdivision does not
- 20 apply to a caterer or other establishment providing food for the event if
- 21 the caterer or establishment receives compensation for providing the
- 22 food;
- 23 (8) The location where food prepared by a caterer is served so long
- 24 as the caterer only minimally handles the food at the serving location;
- 25 (9) Educational institutions, health care facilities, nursing homes,
- 26 and governmental organizations which are inspected by a state agency or a
- 27 political subdivision other than the regulatory authority for sanitation
- 28 in the food preparation areas;
- 29 (10) A pharmacy as defined in section 71-425 if the pharmacy only
- 30 sells prepackaged pharmaceutical, medicinal, or health supplement foods
- 31 that are not potentially hazardous or foods described in subdivision (1)

- 1 of this section; and
- 2 (11) An establishment which is not a commercial food establishment
- 3 and which sells only commercially packaged foods that are not potentially
- 4 hazardous foods.
- 5 Sec. 2. Original section 81-2,245.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 6 Nebraska, is repealed.
