LEGISLATIVE BILL 571

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Tourism Commission; to amend sections 81-3711 and 81-3714, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require the commission to mark significant tourism attractions;
- 4 to prohibit the posting or erection of a highway tourism marker on
- 5 public property; to provide a penalty; to harmonize provisions; and
- 6 to repeal the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-3711, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 81-3711 The commission shall:
- 4 (1) Administer the Nebraska Visitors Development Act;
- 5 (2) Prepare and approve a budget;
- 6 (3) Elect a chairperson and vice-chairperson;
- 7 (4) Procure and evaluate data and information necessary for the 8 proper administration of the act;
- 9 (5) Appoint an executive director to conduct the day-to-day operations of the commission;
- 11 (6) Employ personnel and contract for services which are necessary 12 for the proper operation of the commission;
- (7) Establish a means by which any interested person has the opportunity at least annually to offer his or her ideas and suggestions relative to the commission's duties for the upcoming year;
- 16 (8) Authorize the expenditure of funds and contracting of 17 expenditures to carry out the act;
- (9) Keep minutes of its meetings and other books and records which
 clearly reflect all of the actions and transactions of the commission and
 keep such records open to examination during normal business hours;—and
- (10) Prohibit any funds appropriated to the commission from being expended directly or indirectly to promote or oppose any candidate for public office or to influence state or federal legislation; and -
- 24 <u>(11) Mark significant tourism attractions as provided in section 2</u> 25 <u>of this act.</u>
- Sec. 2. <u>(1) The Nebraska Tourism Commission shall mark significant</u> tourism attractions in Nebraska.
- (2) The commission shall have authority to (a) determine what tourism attractions are important to the State of Nebraska and to justify
 the expenditure of public funds for the purchase of markers of uniform style to be known as highway tourism markers, (b) procure such markers by

- 1 expending funds specifically appropriated by the Legislature for such
- 2 purpose and to designate the approximate location of such markers, (c)
- 3 preserve, replace, or modify markers, and (d) accept gifts and to
- 4 encourage local participation in and contribution to the erection of such
- 5 <u>markers through the use of gifts and matching-fund agreements. Such funds</u>
- 6 shall be deposited into the State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund. The
- 7 commission may appoint and delegate to a special committee the duties of
- 8 research and investigation to assist in the determination of tourism
- 9 attractions that should be designated by such markers. The Department of
- 10 Roads shall erect and maintain such markers and shall determine the exact
- 11 <u>location of such markers with consideration given for the safety and</u>
- 12 <u>welfare of the public.</u>
- 13 (3) The commission may secure payment to the state for the actual
- 14 <u>replacement cost of any markers damaged or destroyed, accidentally or</u>
- 15 otherwise. Any funds so collected shall be remitted to the State
- 16 Treasurer for credit to the State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund for the
- 17 procurement of highway tourism markers.
- 18 (4) It shall be unlawful for any person, public or private
- 19 corporation, association, or organization to post, erect, or maintain any
- 20 <u>highway tourism marker on public property or upon any public street,</u>
- 21 road, or highway in the state bearing any legend, inscription, or notice
- 22 which purports to mark a tourism attraction or to maintain any highway
- 23 tourism marker posted or erected after the effective date of this act,
- 24 unless a written certificate of approval has first been secured from the
- 25 commission.
- 26 (5) Nothing in this act shall be construed to restrict the placement
- 27 <u>of any marker or signage on private property.</u>
- 28 (6) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (4) of this
- 29 section shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor. Each day that a
- 30 violation continues after notice shall constitute a separate offense.
- 31 Sec. 3. Section 81-3714, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 81-3714 The State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund is created. The
- 3 commission shall use the proceeds of the fund to generally promote,
- 4 encourage, and attract visitors to and within the State of Nebraska, to
- 5 <u>erect and replace highway tourism markers</u>, and <u>to</u>enhance the use of
- 6 travel and tourism facilities within the state. The proceeds of the fund
- 7 shall be in addition to funds appropriated to the commission from the
- 8 General Fund. Any money in the State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund
- 9 available for investment shall be invested by the state investment
- 10 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 11 State Funds Investment Act.
