1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-2301,
2	2-2304, 2-3601, 2-3611, 2-3612, 2-3615, 2-3627, 2-3629, 2-3634,
3	2-3635, 2-3735, 2-3745, 2-3746, and 2-3747, Reissue Revised Statutes
4	of Nebraska; to provide for redesignation of districts of members of
5	various commodities boards or commissions as prescribed; to provide
6	for changing the number of at-large members; to harmonize
7	provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
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8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 2-2301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

2-2301 Sections 2-2301 to 2-2321 and section 3 of this act shall be
known and may be cited as the Nebraska Wheat Resources Act.

5 Sec. 2. Section 2-2304, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is6 amended to read:

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2-2304 Except as provided in section 3 of this act:

(1) The board shall be composed of seven members who shall (a) be 8 9 citizens of Nebraska, (b) be at least twenty-one years of age, (c) have 10 been actually engaged in growing wheat in this state for a period of at least five years, and (d) derive a substantial portion of their income 11 from growing wheat. The Director of Agriculture and the vice chancellor 12 of the University of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural 13 Resources shall serve as nonvoting members of the board. With the 14 exception of the nonvoting members, the Governor shall appoint the 15 members to the board; and -16

17 (2) The seven appointed members shall be appointed from the18 following districts:

19 (a) District 1: The counties of Sioux, Scotts Bluff, Dawes, Box20 Butte, Morrill, Sheridan, and Garden;

21 (b) District 2: The counties of Kimball, Banner, and Cheyenne;

(c) District 3: The counties of Perkins, Deuel, Keith, Arthur,
McPherson, Logan, Grant, Hooker, Thomas, and Cherry;

24 (d) District 4: The counties of Lincoln, Chase, Dundy, Hayes,
25 Hitchcock, and Frontier;

(e) District 5: The counties of Buffalo, Dawson, Phelps, Custer,
 Gosper, Kearney, Red Willow, Furnas, Harlan, and Franklin;

(f) District 6: The counties of Adams, Webster, Nuckolls, Thayer,
Jefferson, Gage, Johnson, Nemaha, Pawnee, Richardson, Otoe, Cass,
Lancaster, Seward, York, Hamilton, Hall, Sherman, Howard, Merrick, Nance,
Polk, Butler, Saunders, Sarpy, Douglas, Washington, Dodge, Colfax,

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Platte, Burt, Cuming, Stanton, Madison, Boone, Valley, Greeley, Antelope,
 Pierce, Wayne, Thurston, Dakota, Dixon, Cedar, Knox, Wheeler, Garfield,
 Loup, Blaine, Brown, Rock, Holt, Boyd, Keya Paha, Clay, Fillmore, and
 Saline; and

5 (g) District 7: The at-large district.

The board shall be responsible for the administration of 6 Sec. 3. 7 all subsequent appointments for membership on the board and may adopt rules and regulations to carry out such responsibility. The composition 8 9 of the board as defined by section 2-2304 shall continue until such time 10 as the board determines that the districts and at-large membership as defined by such section are incompatible with an equitable representation 11 12 of producers of wheat due to changing geographic distribution of wheat production in the state, changing marketing patterns, or availability of 13 gualified individuals to serve as board members. The board may, from time 14 to time as appropriate, by rule and regulation, redesignate districts and 15 the number of at-large members to provide for an equitable representation 16 17 of producers of wheat.

Sec. 4. Section 2-3601, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

2-3601 Sections 2-3601 to 2-3635 <u>and section 12 of this act shall be</u>
known and may be cited as the Nebraska Corn Resources Act.

22 Sec. 5. Section 2-3611, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 23 amended to read:

24 2-3611 The board shall be composed of nine members who (1) are 25 citizens of Nebraska, (2) are at least twenty-one years of age, (3) have 26 been actually engaged in growing corn in this state for a period of at 27 least five years, and (4) derive a substantial portion of their income 28 from growing corn.

The Director of Agriculture, the vice chancellor of the University Of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources, and the president of the Nebraska Corn Growers Association shall be ex officio

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1 members of the board but shall have no vote in board matters.

Sec. 6. Section 2-3612, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

2-3612 Except for the position of the at-large members member, whenever a vacancy occurs on the board for any reason, the Governor shall appoint an individual to fill such vacancy from the district in which the vacancy exists. If the vacant position is that of <u>an the</u> at-large member, the appointment to fill such vacancy shall be made at large by the board.

9 Sec. 7. Section 2-3615, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 10 amended to read:

2-3615 <u>Except as provided in section 12 of this act, one</u> One member
 shall be appointed from each of the following districts:

(a) District 1. The counties of Butler, Saunders, Douglas, Sarpy,
Seward, Lancaster, Cass, Otoe, Saline, Jefferson, Gage, Johnson, Nemaha,
Pawnee, and Richardson;

(b) District 2. The counties of Adams, Clay, Fillmore, Franklin,
Webster, Nuckolls, and Thayer;

18 (c) District 3. The counties of Merrick, Polk, Hamilton, and York;

(d) District 4. The counties of Knox, Cedar, Dixon, Dakota, Pierce,

Scotts Bluff, Banner, Kimball, Morrill, Cheyenne, Garden, Deuel, Cherry,
Keya Paha, Brown, Rock, Grant, Hooker, Thomas, Blaine, Loup, Arthur,
McPherson, Logan, Custer, Keith, Lincoln, Perkins, Chase, and Dundy.

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Sec. 8. Section 2-3627, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

2-3627 Until December 31, 1978, the fee levied pursuant to section 3 2-3623 shall not exceed one-tenth of one cent per bushel. Beginning 4 January 1, 1979, the board may, whenever it shall determine that the fees 5 provided by section 2-3623 are yielding more than is required to carry 6 7 out the intent and purposes of the Nebraska Corn Resources Act sections 2-3601 to 2-3635, reduce such fees for such period as it shall deem 8 9 justified, but not less than one year. If the board, after reducing such 10 fees finds that sufficient revenue is not being produced by such reduced fees, it may restore in full or in part such fees not to exceed four-11 tenths of a cent per bushel. 12

20 2-3634 The board shall not be authorized to set up research or 21 development units or agencies of its own, but shall limit its activity to 22 cooperation and contracts with the University of Nebraska Institute of 23 Agriculture and Natural Resources and other proper local, state, or 24 national organizations, public or private, in carrying out the purposes 25 of the Nebraska Corn Resources Act sections 2-3601 to 2-3635.

18	2-3745 <u>The</u> There is hereby created the Dry Bean Commission <u>is</u>
19	created. Except as provided in section 17 of this act, the commission
20	which shall be composed of nine members, two of whom shall be selected by
21	the commission and seven of whom shall be appointed by the Governor.
22	Commission members shall be appointed on a nonpartisan basis. Six members
23	shall be growers who (1) are citizens of Nebraska, (2) are at least
24	twenty-one years of age, (3) have actually been engaged in growing dry
25	beans in this state for at least three years, and (4) derive a
26	substantial portion of their income from growing dry beans. Three members
27	shall be dry bean processors who have been in business in Nebraska for at

3 (1) The Governor shall appoint one grower member from each of the4 following four districts:

5 (a) District 1 which shall consist of the counties of Sioux, Dawes,6 Sheridan, and Box Butte;

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(b) District 2 which shall consist of the county of Scotts Bluff;

8 (c) District 3 which shall consist of the counties of Banner,9 Morrill, Kimball, Cheyenne, Garden, and Deuel; and

10 (d) District 4 which shall consist of the remaining counties in 11 which dry bean production occurs in the state; -

12 (2) The commission shall appoint two grower members to the 13 commission, one of whom resides within district 1 or 2 who shall represent districts 1 and 2 and one of whom resides within district 3 or 14 shall represent districts 3 and 4. Members 15 serving 4 who as representatives of such districts on May 18, 2011, shall continue as 16 17 members of the commission until the end of their terms and until their successors are appointed and qualified and, except as provided in section 18 2-3748, shall be eligible for reappointment; and -19

Insofar as possible, the geographic locations of such appointed members shall be representative of the Nebraska dry bean industry. Any processor may place his or her name on a candidacy list for appointment by written notice to the commission.

27 2-3747 Except as provided in section 17 of this act, Any grower may 28 place his or her name on a candidacy list for appointment as a grower 29 member of the commission by filing a petition signed by at least ten 30 resident bean growers (1) from the district in which he or she resides 31 for an appointment under <u>subdivision</u> subsection (1) of section 2-3746 or

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1 (2) from the district in which he or she resides or the other district to 2 be represented for an appointment under <u>subdivision</u> subsection (2) of 3 section 2-3746. The petition shall be filed with the commission. The 4 Governor and the commission shall make appointments from the candidacy 5 list unless there are no names on the list.

Sec. 17. The commission shall be responsible for the administration 6 7 of all subsequent appointments for membership on the commission and may adopt rules and regulations to carry out such responsibility. The 8 9 composition of the commission as defined by section 2-3746 shall continue 10 until such time as the commission determines that the districts and at-<u>large membership as defined by such section are incompatible with an</u> 11 equitable representation of producers of dry beans due to changing 12 13 geographic distribution of dry bean production in the state, changing 14 marketing patterns, or availability of qualified individuals to serve as commission members. The commission may, from time to time as appropriate, 15 by rule and regulation, redesignate districts and the number of at-large 16 17 members to provide for an equitable representation of producers of dry 18 beans.
