- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Game Law; to amend section 37-421.01,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to provide for a
- 3 discounted permit for deployed military and spouses while on leave
- 4 as described; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 37-421.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 37-421.01 (1) Notwithstanding any provision of section 37-407 to the
- 4 contrary, a Nebraska resident who is deployed out of state with a branch
- 5 of the United States military or has been so deployed within the last
- 6 twelve months at the time of application shall be entitled to receive an
- 7 annual combination fishing and hunting permit, habitat stamp, aquatic
- 8 habitat stamp, and Nebraska migratory waterfowl stamp on a one-time basis
- 9 upon returning to the state if the resident:
- 10 (a) Submits an application to the commission with a fee of five
- 11 dollars; and
- 12 (b) Provides to the commission evidence of the resident's deployment
- 13 out of state.
- 14 (2)(a) Notwithstanding any provision of section 37-447, 37-449,
- 15 37-450, 37-451, or 37-457 to the contrary, a Nebraska resident who
- 16 purchased a big game permit and who was deployed out of state with a
- 17 branch of the United States military for the entire season of the hunt
- 18 and who was unable to use the permit shall be entitled to receive a
- 19 discounted permit on a one-time basis upon returning to the state if the
- 20 resident provides to the commission evidence of deployment.
- 21 Alternatively, the member of the military may request a refund of the
- 22 amount paid for a big game permit and the commission shall pay such
- 23 amount.
- 24 (b) For purposes of this subsection, big game means antelope, deer,
- 25 elk, mountain sheep, and wild turkeys.
- 26 (c) The commission shall establish a fee of five dollars for the
- 27 discounted permits authorized in this subsection.
- 28 <u>(3)(a) Notwithstanding any provision of section 37-407 to the</u>
- 29 <u>contrary:</u>
- 30 (i) A Nebraska resident who is deployed out of state with a branch
- 31 of the United States military and who is in Nebraska on leave from such

- 1 deployment shall be entitled to receive a combination fishing and hunting
- 2 permit valid until the final day of leave if the resident complies with
- 3 <u>subdivision (b) of this subsection; and</u>
- 4 (ii) The spouse of a Nebraska resident who is deployed out of state
- 5 <u>with a branch of the United States military and who is in Nebraska on</u>
- 6 leave from such deployment shall be entitled to receive a combination
- 7 fishing and hunting permit valid until the final day of leave if the
- 8 spouse complies with subdivision (b) of this subsection.
- 9 <u>(b) The resident or spouse shall:</u>
- 10 (i) Submit an application to the commission with a fee of five
- 11 <u>dollars for each permit;</u>
- 12 <u>(ii) Provide to the commission evidence of the resident's deployment</u>
- 13 <u>out of state; and</u>
- 14 (iii) Provide to the commission evidence of the resident's period of
- 15 leave.
- 16 $(\underline{4} \ 3)$ The commission may authorize electronic issuance of the
- 17 discounted permits authorized under this section.
- 18 (5 4) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 19 that set forth the procedures for applying for, and the issuance of, the
- 20 discounted permits authorized in this section, including what constitutes
- 21 evidence of deployment to qualify for the permits.
