- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Open Meetings Act; to amend section
- 2 84-1413, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate
- 3 provisions relating to secret ballots; and to repeal the original
- 4 section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 84-1413, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-1413 (1) Each public body shall keep minutes of all meetings
- 4 showing the time, place, members present and absent, and the substance of
- 5 all matters discussed.
- 6 (2) Any action taken on any question or motion duly moved and
- 7 seconded shall be by roll call vote of the public body in open session,
- 8 and the record shall state how each member voted or if the member was
- 9 absent or not voting. The requirements of a roll call or viva voce vote
- 10 shall be satisfied by a municipality, a county, a learning community, a
- 11 joint entity created pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, a joint
- 12 public agency created pursuant to the Joint Public Agency Act, or an
- 13 agency formed under the Municipal Cooperative Financing Act which
- 14 utilizes an electronic voting device which allows the yeas and nays of
- 15 each member of such city council, village board, county board, or
- 16 governing body to be readily seen by the public.
- 17 (3) The vote to elect leadership within a public body may be taken
- 18 by secret ballot, but the total number of votes for each candidate shall
- 19 be recorded in the minutes.
- 20 (3 4) The minutes of all meetings and evidence and documentation
- 21 received or disclosed in open session shall be public records and open to
- 22 public inspection during normal business hours.
- 23 (4 5) Minutes shall be written and available for inspection within
- 24 ten working days or prior to the next convened meeting, whichever occurs
- 25 earlier, except that cities of the second class and villages may have an
- 26 additional ten working days if the employee responsible for writing the
- 27 minutes is absent due to a serious illness or emergency.
