## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 649**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public records; to amend section 84-712.01,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide that certain votes
- of public officials are public record; and to repeal the original
- 4 section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 84-712.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 84-712.01 (1) Except when any other statute expressly provides that
- 4 particular information or records shall not be made public, public
- 5 records shall include all records and documents, regardless of physical
- 6 form, of or belonging to this state, any county, city, village, political
- 7 subdivision, or tax-supported district in this state, or any agency,
- 8 branch, department, board, bureau, commission, council, subunit, or
- 9 committee of any of the foregoing. Data which is a public record in its
- 10 original form shall remain a public record when maintained in computer
- 11 files. All votes taken by public officials in the course of their public
- 12 <u>duties shall be considered public record.</u>
- 13 (2) When a custodian of a public record of a county provides to a
- 14 member of the public, upon request, a copy of the public record by
- 15 transmitting it from a modem to an outside modem, a reasonable fee may be
- 16 charged for such specialized service. Such fee may include a reasonable
- 17 amount representing a portion of the amortization of the cost of computer
- 18 equipment, including software, necessarily added in order to provide such
- 19 specialized service. This subsection shall not be construed to require a
- 20 governmental entity to acquire computer capability to generate public
- 21 records in a new or different form when that new form would require
- 22 additional computer equipment or software not already possessed by the
- 23 governmental entity.
- 24 (3) Sections 84-712 to 84-712.03 shall be liberally construed
- 25 whenever any state, county, or political subdivision fiscal records,
- 26 audit, warrant, voucher, invoice, purchase order, requisition, payroll,
- 27 check, receipt, or other record of receipt, cash, or expenditure
- 28 involving public funds is involved in order that the citizens of this
- 29 state shall have the full right to know of and have full access to
- 30 information on the public finances of the government and the public
- 31 bodies and entities created to serve them.
