1 Section 1. Section 38-2890, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is

- 3 38-2890 (1) All pharmacy technicians employed by a health care
- 4 facility licensed under the Health Care Facility Licensure Act shall be
- 5 registered with the Pharmacy Technician Registry created in section
- 6 38-2893. In order to be employed as a pharmacy technician in such a
- 7 health care facility, a pharmacy technician (a) shall be certified by a
- 8 state or national certifying body which is approved by the board (i) by
- 9 January 1, 2017, if he or she was registered with the Pharmacy Technician
- 10 Registry on January 1, 2016, or (ii) within one year after being
- 11 <u>registered with the Pharmacy Technician Registry, if he or she was so</u>
- 12 <u>registered after January 1, 2016, and (b) upon being so certified, shall</u>
- 13 <u>maintain current certification during the time he or she is so</u>
- 14 <u>registered.</u>
- 15 (2) To register as a pharmacy technician, an individual shall (a) be
- 16 at least eighteen years of age, (b) be a high school graduate or be
- 17 officially recognized by the State Department of Education as possessing
- 18 the equivalent degree of education, (c) have never been convicted of any
- 19 nonalcohol, drug-related misdemeanor or felony, (d) file an application
- 20 with the <u>Division of Public Health of the Department of Health and Human</u>
- 21 <u>Services</u> department, and (e) pay the applicable fee.
- 22 (3) Beginning January 1, 2017, a pharmacy technician shall be
- 23 certified by a state or national certifying body approved by the board in
- 24 order to be employed as a pharmacy technician in a health care facility.
- 25 Sec. 2. Original section 38-2890, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 26 2015, is repealed.
- 27 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 28 passed and approved according to law.
