- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state universities; to amend section
 85-421, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to create the
 University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016; to provide powers
 and duties for the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska
 relating to construction and improvement projects; to repeal the
 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature finds and determines that preserving
- 2 the investments in buildings through the completion of deferred
- 3 maintenance, repair, renovation, and facility replacement construction
- 4 projects is of critical importance to the State of Nebraska;
- 5 (2) The Legislature acknowledges that higher education is key to the
- 6 <u>long-term economic well-being of the State of Nebraska and that</u>
- 7 competitive facilities are critical to attracting students and faculty;
- 8 (3) The Legislature recognizes that addressing the continued
- 9 deterioration of buildings, limiting the effects of inflation on the
- 10 costs of such deferred maintenance construction, and bringing such
- 11 <u>buildings into compliance with current health and safety requirements at</u>
- 12 <u>the earliest possible time is necessary for protecting such investments</u>
- in the buildings of the State of Nebraska;
- 14 (4) The Legislature recognizes that, in order to accomplish these
- 15 goals, it is necessary, desirable, and advisable that the Legislature
- 16 provide for the receipt of funds for such purposes as soon as practicable
- 17 with the repayment of such funds to be made over a period of years;
- 18 (5) The Legislature recognizes the commitment of the Board of
- 19 Regents of the University of Nebraska to provide matching funds on a one-
- 20 <u>to-one basis up to twenty-two million dollars per year for the period</u>
- 21 beginning with the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2016, and continuing
- 22 through the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2029, for a total of up to two
- 23 hundred forty-two million dollars to supplement amounts appropriated from
- 24 <u>the General Fund pursuant to section 3 of this act.</u>
- 25 Sec. 2. The University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016 is
- 26 created. All funds appropriated to the program by the Legislature shall
- 27 be used exclusively for deferred maintenance, repair, renovation,
- 28 <u>facility addition</u>, and <u>facility replacement construction projects</u>
- 29 <u>authorized pursuant to section 3 of this act.</u>
- 30 Sec. 3. (1) The Legislature shall appropriate from the General Fund
- 31 (a) an amount not less than eleven million dollars for each fiscal year

- 1 for the period beginning with the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2016,
- 2 and continuing through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, and (b) an
- 3 amount not less than twenty-two million dollars for each fiscal year for
- 4 the period beginning with the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2018, and
- 5 continuing through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2028, to the
- 6 University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016 created pursuant to
- 7 section 2 of this act to be used by the Board of Regents of the
- 8 University of Nebraska to accomplish projects as provided in this
- 9 section. Through the allotment process established in section 81-1113,
- 10 the Department of Administrative Services shall make appropriated funds
- 11 available. Undisbursed appropriation balances existing in the University
- 12 <u>of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016 at the end of each fiscal year</u>
- 13 until June 30, 2029, shall be and are hereby reappropriated.
- 14 (2) The Legislature finds and determines that the projects funded
- 15 through the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016 are of
- 16 critical importance to the State of Nebraska. It is the intent of the
- 17 <u>Legislature that the appropriations to the program shall not be reduced</u>
- 18 <u>until all contracts and securities relating to the construction and</u>
- 19 <u>financing of the projects or portions of the projects funded from such</u>
- 20 <u>funds or accounts of such funds are completed or paid but in no case</u>
- 21 shall such appropriations extend beyond the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 22 2029, nor shall the cumulative total of the General Fund appropriations
- 23 for the program exceed two hundred forty-two million dollars.
- 24 (3) Subject to the receipt of project approval from the Coordinating
- 25 Commission for Postsecondary Education as required by subsection (10) of
- 26 section 85-1414 for each of the following University of Nebraska
- 27 projects, the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is
- 28 authorized to make expenditures from the University of Nebraska
- 29 Facilities Program of 2016 for the deferred maintenance, repair,
- 30 renovation, facility addition, or facility replacement construction of
- 31 the following facility projects: (a) University of Nebraska-Lincoln

- 1 Nebraska Hall; (b) University of Nebraska-Lincoln Scott Engineering
- 2 Center; (c) University of Nebraska-Lincoln Mabel Lee Hall/Henzlik Hall;
- 3 (d) University of Nebraska-Lincoln Food Industry Complex; (e) University
- 4 of Nebraska-Lincoln College of Business Administration; (f) University of
- 5 Nebraska-Lincoln Manter/Hamilton Hall; (g) University of Nebraska Medical
- 6 Center Wittson Hall; (h) University of Nebraska Medical Center College of
- 7 Nursing; (i) University of Nebraska Medical Center Joseph D. & Millie E.
- 8 Williams Science Hall (College of Pharmacy); (j) University of Nebraska
- 9 Medical Center Eppley Science Hall; (k) University of Nebraska Medical
- 10 Center Administration Center; (1) an expansion of an existing building or
- 11 construction of a new building at the University of Nebraska at Omaha;
- 12 <u>(m) University of Nebraska at Omaha Durham Science Center; (n) University</u>
- 13 of Nebraska at Omaha Arts and Sciences Hall; (o) University of Nebraska
- 14 at Omaha Strauss Performing Arts Center; (p) University of Nebraska at
- 15 Kearney Otto C. Olsen Building; and (q) University of Nebraska at Kearney
- 16 Fine Arts Building.
- 17 (4) Expenditures of matching funds provided for the projects listed
- 18 in this section by the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska as
- 19 provided for in section 1 of this act shall be accounted for in the
- 20 Nebraska State Accounting System through the University of Nebraska
- 21 Facilities Program of 2016 or according to some other reporting process
- 22 mutually agreed upon by the University of Nebraska and the Department of
- 23 <u>Administrative Services.</u>
- 24 (5) The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall record
- 25 and report, on the Nebraska State Accounting System, expenditure of
- 26 <u>amounts from the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016 and</u>
- 27 <u>expenditure of proceeds arising from any contract entered into pursuant</u>
- 28 to this section and section 4 of this act in such manner and format as
- 29 prescribed by the Department of Administrative Services or according to
- 30 some other reporting process mutually agreed upon by the University of
- 31 Nebraska and the Department of Administrative Services.

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1 (1) In order to accomplish any projects authorized by 2 section 3 of this act, the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska 3 may enter into contracts with any person, firm, or corporation providing 4 for the implementation of any such project of the University of Nebraska 5 and providing for the long-term financing of the cost of such project from the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2016. In no case 6 7 shall any such contract extend for a period beyond December 31, 2029, nor shall any such contract exceed the repayment capabilities implicit in the 8 9 funding streams as described and authorized in sections 1 to 4 of this 10 <u>act.</u> (2) The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall not 11 pledge the credit of the State of Nebraska for the payment of any sum 12 13 owing on account of such contract, except that there may be pledged for the payment of any such contract any appropriation specifically made by 14 the Legislature for such purpose, together with such funds of the Board 15 of Regents of the University of Nebraska as the Board of Regents 16 17 determines. No contract shall be entered into pursuant to this section without prior approval by resolution of the Board of Regents. The Board 18 19 of Regents may also convey, lease, or lease back all or any part of the projects authorized by section 3 of this act and the land on which such 20 projects are situated to such person, firm, or corporation as the Board 21 22 of Regents may contract with pursuant to this section to facilitate the long-term payment of the cost of such projects. Any such conveyance or 23 24 lease shall provide that when the cost of such projects has been paid, 25 together with interest and other costs thereon, such projects and the 26 land on which such projects are located shall become the property of the 27 Board of Regents. 28 (3) The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is authorized to make expenditures for the purposes stated in this section and section 29 3 of this act from investment income earned on balances in any fund 30

created under the authority provided for in any contract or contracts

- authorized by this section. Any appropriated amounts and amounts 1 2 <u>designated</u> or <u>matched</u> by the <u>Board</u> of <u>Regents</u> as <u>described</u> under <u>section</u> 1 of this act for payment of debt service in excess of amounts required 3 4 to meet debt service and any interest earnings derived from reserve funds 5 or any other funds created under the authority provided for in any contract or contracts authorized by this section may be applied toward 6 7 early retirement of debt as authorized under any resolution, indenture, or other contract entered into by the Board of Regents as authorized by 8 this section. The Board of Regents and the Department of Administrative 9 10 Services shall, prior to such time that the Board enters into any longterm contract to finance the projects described in section 3 of this act, 11 enter into a disposition agreement providing for the allocation and 12 distribution of any balances existing in the University of Nebraska 13 Facilities Program of 2016 or any other funds created as part of a long-14 15 term contract entered into by the Board of Regents pursuant to this section. The distribution of any such balances to the General Fund or the 16 17 Board of Regents as provided in such disposition agreement shall occur either on December 31, 2030, or when all financial obligations incurred 18 19 in the contracts entered into by the Board of Regents pursuant to this section are discharged, whichever occurs first. 20 Sec. 5. - 7 (2) The Legislature finds and determines that the projects funded
- 8 through the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2006 are of
- 9 critical importance to the State of Nebraska. It is the intent of the
- 10 Legislature that the appropriations to the program shall not be reduced
- 11 until all contracts and securities relating to the construction and
- 12 financing of the projects or portions of the projects funded from such
- 13 funds or accounts of such funds are completed or paid but in no case
- 14 shall such appropriations extend beyond the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 15 <u>2018</u> 2020, nor shall the cumulative total of the General Fund
- 16 appropriations for the program exceed one hundred thirty-seven million
- 17 five hundred thousand dollars.
- 18 (3) Subject to the receipt of project approval from the Coordinating
- 19 Commission for Postsecondary Education as required by subsection (10) of
- 20 section 85-1414 for each of the following University of Nebraska
- 21 projects, the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is
- 22 authorized to make expenditures from the University of Nebraska
- 23 Facilities Program of 2006 for the following projects: (a) Deferred
- 24 maintenance, repair, and renovation of University of Nebraska at Kearney
- 25 Bruner Hall; (b) construction of University of Nebraska at Kearney
- 26 campus-wide central utilities plant and system; (c) construction of
- 27 facilities to replace University of Nebraska-Lincoln Behlen, Brace, and
- 28 Ferguson Halls or deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of
- 29 University of Nebraska-Lincoln Behlen, Brace, and Ferguson Halls; (d)
- 30 construction of a facility to replace University of Nebraska-Lincoln Keim
- 31 Hall or deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of University of

- Nebraska-Lincoln Keim Hall; (e) deferred maintenance, repair, 1 and 2 renovation of University of Nebraska-Lincoln Sheldon Memorial Art Gallery; (f) deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of University 3 4 of Nebraska-Lincoln Animal Science Complex; (g) deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of University of Nebraska Medical Center Poynter, 5 and Wittson Halls; (h) deferred maintenance, 6 repair, 7 renovation of University of Nebraska Medical Center Eppley Institute for Research in Cancer and Allied Diseases or replacement if additional 8 9 federal or private funds are received; (i) deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of University of Nebraska Medical Center College of 10 Dentistry; (j) deferred maintenance, repair, and renovation of University 11 of Nebraska at Omaha Library; and (k) deferred maintenance, repair, and 12 renovation of University of Nebraska at Omaha utilities infrastructure. 13
- (4) Expenditures of matching funds provided for the projects listed in this section by the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska as provided for in section 85-419 shall be accounted for in the Nebraska State Accounting System through the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2006 or according to some other reporting process mutually agreed upon by the University of Nebraska and the Department of Administrative Services.
- (5) The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall record 21 and report, on the Nebraska State Accounting System, expenditure of 22 amounts from the University of Nebraska Facilities Program of 2006 and 23 24 expenditure of proceeds arising from any contract entered into pursuant to this section and section 85-422 in such manner and format as 25 prescribed by the Department of Administrative Services or according to 26 some other reporting process mutually agreed upon by the University of 27 28 Nebraska and the Department of Administrative Services.
- (6) The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall provide to the Task Force for Building Renewal semiannual reports concerning the status of each project authorized by this section.
