- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act;
- 2 to amend sections 81-2201, 81-2213, 81-2218, 81-2220, 81-2221, and
- 3 81-2235, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change and
- 4 eliminate provisions relating to area plans and budgets as
- 5 prescribed; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original
- 6 sections; and to outright repeal section 81-2228, Reissue Revised
- 7 Statutes of Nebraska.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 81-2201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 81-2201 Sections 81-2201 to <u>81-2227</u> <del>81-2228</del> shall be known and may
- 4 be cited as the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 81-2213, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 81-2213 The department shall have the following powers and duties:
- 8 (1) To develop, approve, and submit to the Governor a two-year,
- 9 three-year, or four-year state plan on aging, as determined by the
- 10 department, for purposes of administering grant funds allocated to the
- 11 state under the federal Older Americans Act of 1965, as such act existed
- 12 <u>on January 1, 2016</u>, <del>as now or hereafter amended,</del> or administering state
- 13 funds allocated to the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act;
- 14 (2) To cooperate with similar departments, commissions, or councils
- in the federal government and in other states;
- 16 (3) To adopt and promulgate rules, regulations, and bylaws governing
- 17 its procedure and activities and as necessary to carry out the policies
- 18 of the department and the policies prescribed by the Administration on
- 19 Aging pursuant to the federal Older Americans Act of 1965, as such act
- 20 <u>existed on January 1, 2016</u>, as now or hereafter amended;
- 21 (4) To create committees to aid in the discharge of its powers and
- 22 duties;
- 23 (5) To cooperate with and assist other state and local governmental
- 24 agencies and officials on matters relating to services for older
- 25 individuals;
- 26 (6) To divide the state into planning-and-service areas as provided
- 27 in section 71-807 for behavioral health regions, except that Regions 3
- 28 and 5 may each be divided into two planning-and-service areas with
- 29 boundaries as established by the department for planning-and-service
- 30 areas in existence in those regions on July 1, 1982;
- 31 (7) To establish minimum standards for program operations and to

- 1 adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for the performance of area
- 2 agencies on aging and for any services provided by such area agencies on
- 3 aging which are funded in whole or in part under the Nebraska Community
- 4 Aging Services Act or the federal Older Americans Act of 1965, as such
- 5 <u>federal act existed on January 1, 2016</u>, as now or hereafter amended;
- 6 (8) To require the submission of a <u>two-year</u>, three-year, or four-
- 7 year one-year and a five-year area plan and budget by each area agency on
- 8 aging or agency seeking designation as an area agency on aging. Such
- 9 plans and budgets shall be submitted sixty days prior to the start of
- 10 each fiscal year in accordance with the uniform area plan format and
- other instructions issued by the department;
- 12 (9) To review and approve a <u>two-year</u>, three-year, or four-year one-
- 13 year and a five-year area plan and budget for the support of each area
- 14 agency on aging and the provision of eligible activities and services as
- 15 defined in section 81-2222;
- 16 (10) To adopt and submit electronically to the Legislature a
- 17 community aging services budget;
- 18 (11) To review the performance of each area agency on aging and,
- 19 based on the department-approved area plan and budget, to determine the
- 20 continued designation or the withdrawal of the designation of an area
- 21 agency on aging receiving or requesting resources through the state or
- 22 under the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act or the federal Older
- 23 Americans Act<u>of 1965, as such federal act existed on January 1, 2016</u> 7
- 24 as now or hereafter amended. After consultation with the director of the
- 25 area agency on aging and the governing unit of the area agency on aging,
- 26 the department may withdraw a designation when it can be shown that
- 27 federal or state laws, rules, or regulations have not been complied with,
- 28 state or federal funds are not being expended for the purposes for which
- 29 they were intended, or older individuals are not receiving appropriate
- 30 services within available resources. Withdrawal of a designation may be
- 31 appealed to the department. Upon withdrawal of a designation, the

- 1 department may temporarily perform all or part of the functions and
- 2 responsibilities of the area agency on aging, may designate another
- 3 agency to perform such functions and responsibilities identified by the
- 4 department until the designation of a new area agency on aging, and, when
- 5 deemed necessary, may temporarily deliver services to assure continuity;
- 6 (12) To conduct continuing studies and analyses of the problems
- 7 faced by older individuals within the state and develop such
- 8 recommendations for administrative or legislative action as appear
- 9 necessary;
- 10 (13) To develop grants and plans, enter into contracts, accept
- 11 gifts, grants, and federal funds, and do all things necessary and proper
- 12 to discharge these powers and duties;
- 13 (14) To accept and administer any other programs or resources
- 14 delegated, designated, assigned, or awarded to the department from public
- 15 or private sources; and
- 16 (15) Such other powers and duties necessary to effectively implement
- 17 the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act.
- 18 Sec. 3. Section 81-2218, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 19 amended to read:
- 20 81-2218 The governing unit of the designated area agency on aging
- 21 shall:
- 22 (1) In accordance with section 81-2219, employ a qualified
- 23 administrator to serve as the chief executive officer for the
- 24 administration of the agency and employ adequate staff for carrying out
- 25 the area program plan;
- 26 (2) Approve and submit  $\underline{an}$  a one-year and a five-year area plan and
- 27 budget to the department <u>pursuant to section 81-2213</u> by July 1 of each
- 28 year. The plan shall comply with the requirements of the Nebraska
- 29 Community Aging Services Act and the <u>federal</u>Older Americans Act<u>of 1965</u>,
- 30 <u>as such federal act existed on January 1, 2016</u> , as now or hereafter
- 31 amended;

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- 1 (3) Approve such contracts and agreements as are necessary to carry
- 2 out the functions of the agency; and
- 3 (4) Establish and consult with an area advisory council on needs,
- 4 services, and policies affecting older individuals in the area. The
- 5 advisory council for the area agency on aging shall establish bylaws
- 6 which specify the role and functions of the council, number of members,
- 7 selection of members, term of membership, and frequency of meetings.
- 8 Sec. 4. Section 81-2220, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 81-2220 An area agency on aging shall:
- 11 (1) Monitor, evaluate, and comment on policies, programs, hearings,
- 12 and community actions which affect older individuals;
- 13 (2) Conduct public hearings, studies, and assessments on the needs
- 14 of older individuals living in the planning-and-service area;
- 15 (3) Represent the interests of older individuals to public officials
- 16 and to public and private agencies or organizations;
- 17 (4) Cooperate, coordinate, and plan with other agencies,
- 18 organizations, or individuals to promote benefits and opportunities for
- 19 older individuals consistent with the goals of the Nebraska Community
- 20 Aging Services Act and the <u>federal</u>Older Americans Act<u>of 1965</u>, as such
- 21 <u>federal act existed on January 1, 2016</u>, as now or hereafter amended;
- 22 (5) Develop <u>an a one-year and a five-year</u> area plan and budget
- 23 pursuant to section 81-2213 for a comprehensive, coordinated program of
- 24 community aging services needed by older individuals of the area and
- 25 consistent with the requirements of the Nebraska Community Aging Services
- 26 Act and the <u>federal</u> Older Americans Act<u>of 1965, as such federal act</u>
- 27 <u>existed on January 1, 2016</u>, as now or hereafter amended;
- 28 (6) Monitor and evaluate the activities of service providers to
- 29 ensure that the services being provided comply with the terms of the
- 30 grant or contract. When a provider is found to be in breach of the terms
- 31 of its grant or contract, the area agency on aging shall enforce the

- 1 terms of the grant or contract;
- 2 (7) Comply with rules, regulations, and requirements of the
- 3 department which have been developed in consultation with the area
- 4 agencies on aging for client and fiscal information and provide to the
- 5 department information necessary for federal and state reporting, program
- 6 evaluation, program management, fiscal control, and research needs; and
- 7 (8) Provide technical assistance to service providers as needed,
- 8 prepare written monitoring reports, and provide written reports of onsite
- 9 assessments of all service providers funded by the area agency on aging
- 10 according to the rules and regulations promulgated by the department.
- 11 Sec. 5. Section 81-2221, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 81-2221 The one-year and the five-year area plan and budget adopted
- 14 <u>pursuant to section 81-2220</u> shall contain at least the following:
- 15 (1) Provisions required by the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act
- 16 and the <u>federal Older Americans Act</u> of 1965, as such federal act existed
- 17 on January 1, 2016, as now or hereafter amended; and
- 18 (2) A detailed statement of the manner in which the area agency on
- 19 aging develops, administers, and supports the comprehensive, coordinated
- 20 program of community aging services throughout the area.
- 21 The department may require minimum service levels for the area and
- 22 establish minimum standards for activities which carry out the
- 23 requirements of the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act and the federal
- 24 Older Americans Act of 1965, as such federal act existed on January 1,
- 25 <u>2016</u> , as now or hereafter amended.
- Sec. 6. Section 81-2235, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 27 amended to read:
- 28 81-2235 (1) Each care management unit may be reimbursed by the
- 29 Department of Health and Human Services for costs not paid for by the
- 30 individual or through other reimbursement specified in section 81-2234.
- 31 Reimbursement by the department shall be based on actual casework time

- 1 units expended on all care management services provided and shall include
- 2 expenses for personnel, administration and planning, client eligibility
- 3 review, contractual services, and necessary support services and other
- 4 necessary actual and indirect costs. Standardized rates of reimbursement
- 5 shall be adopted and promulgated by the department and shall be adjusted
- 6 at least every three years.
- 7 (2) Appropriations for reimbursement by the department for services
- 8 provided under sections 81-2229 to 81-2235 and for the costs of the
- 9 department to administer the program shall be appropriated separately
- 10 from funds appropriated under the Nebraska Community Aging Services Act.
- 11 (3) Funds appropriated under this section shall not be used to
- 12 replace funds appropriated under the Nebraska Community Aging Services
- 13 Act and granted to the area agencies on aging prior to August 30, 1987,
- 14 and used to provide case management or care management services in their
- 15 planning-and-service area, except that such funds may be replaced by non-
- 16 Nebraska Community Aging Services funds that are obtained subsequent to
- 17 August 30, 1987, as allowed under rules and regulations adopted and
- 18 promulgated by the Department of Health and Human Services.
- 19 Sec. 7. Original sections 81-2201, 81-2213, 81-2218, 81-2220,
- 20 81-2221, and 81-2235, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 21 Sec. 8. The following section is outright repealed: Section
- 22 81-2228, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
