The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 1090 would implement a system to notify law enforcement officials when persons prohibited from owning a handgun by state or federal law attempt to purchase a handgun.

LB 1090 would require the Nebraska State Patrol to share notifications of denial of certificate to purchase, lease, rent or receive transfer of a handgun to the Attorney General, the United States Attorney for the District of Nebraska, and to the law enforcement agencies and county attorneys that have jurisdiction. The bill would also require the recipients of these notifications to file reports explaining their final disposition on an annual basis.
