The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 575 provides for 9 changes to election law, including the following:

- 1. Clarifies vacancies for all offices must be filled within 45 days.
- 2. Replaces "a majority" with "one-half or more" for vacancies that trigger special election.
- 3. Replaces "ten days" prior to election with "second Friday" as deadline for write in affidavits.
- 4. Allows early voting requests to be submitted via e-mail
- 5. Requires voter history to be completed within 30 days rather than 60 after election.
- 6. Removes outdated language regarding county commissioners.
- 7. Close potential for fusion candidates.
- 8. Removes primary election information from Early Voter return envelopes.
- 9. Adds language allowing the Nebraska Secretary of State to designate a meeting location within the State Capitol for the State Canvassing Board meetings.
