Legislature - First Session - 2015 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB60 Chairman: Senator Les Seiler **Committee: Judiciary** Date of Hearing: January 22, 2015 The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby: Legislative Bill 60 would provide clear guidelines for the transportation and storage of firearms in vehicles in publicly accessible parking lots throughout the State of Nebraska. Currently, many firearm owners are being subject to capricious rules and actions by employers regarding the transportation and storage of firearms by employees and customers in private vehicles in parking lots open to the public. LB335 seeks to bring a balance between the property rights of employers and the property rights of employees and the public to legally transport and store firearms in their private vehicles for self-defense, hunting and any other legal purposes. LB60 would put us in line with 16 other states that have some form of parking lot law for firearms, along with bringing the state policy for the transportation and storage of all firearms

more in line with the Nebraska Concealed Handgun Permit Act, in Section 69-2441

subsections (3) and (4).
