- 3 Section 1. Section 76-1416, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 4 amended to read:
- 5 76-1416 (1) A landlord may not demand or receive security, however
- 6 denominated, in an amount or value in excess of one month's periodic
- 7 rent, except that a pet deposit for cats or dogs in an amount not in
- 8 excess of <del>one-fourth of</del> one month's periodic rent may be demanded or
- 9 received when appropriate. No pet deposit may be demanded for an animal
- 10 that is a service animal or an assistance animal. This , but this
- 11 subsection shall not be applicable to housing agencies organized or
- 12 existing under the Nebraska Housing Agency Act.
- 13 (2) Upon termination of the tenancy, property or money held by the
- 14 landlord as prepaid rent and security may be applied to the payment of
- 15 rent and the amount of damages which the landlord has suffered by reason
- 16 of the tenant's noncompliance with the rental agreement or section
- 17 76-1421. The balance, if any, and a written itemization shall be
- 18 delivered or mailed to the tenant within fourteen days after demand and
- 19 designation of the location where payment may be made or mailed.
- 20 (3) If the landlord fails to comply with subsection (2) of this
- 21 section, the tenant may recover the property and money due him or her and
- 22 reasonable attorney's fees.
- 23 (4) This section does not preclude the landlord or tenant from
- 24 recovering other damages to which he or she may be entitled under the
- 25 Uniform Residential Landlord and Tenant Act.
- 26 (5) The holder of the landlord's interest in the premises at the
- 27 time of the termination of the tenancy is bound by this section.

- 2 <u>(a) Assistance animal means an animal that qualifies as a reasonable</u>
- 3 <u>accommodation under the federal Fair Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. 3601 et seq.</u>,
- 4 <u>as such act existed on January 1, 2018; and</u>
- 5 (b) Service animal has the same meaning as in 28 C.F.R. 36.104, as
- 6 <u>such section existed on January 1, 2018.</u>
