Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1003 increases the number of hours for a military leave of absence from 120 to 360 hours in a calendar year for all employees, including elected officials of the State of Nebraska or any political subdivision, who are serving as members of the National Guard, Army Reserve, Naval Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, Air Force Reserve, and Coast Guard Reserve and work or are normally scheduled to work 159 hours or more in 3 consecutive weeks.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1911 reduces the 360 hours contained in the original bill to 168 hours.
