Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1036 changes the expenditure limit for a recognition dinner under the Local Government Miscellaneous Expenditure Act.

Currently, local government governing boards are authorized by law to hold an annual recognition dinner for election officials, appointed officials, employees, or volunteers at a cost of no more than \$25 per person.

The bill raises this expenditure limit to \$50 per person.
