Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 199 repeals a provision of state aid to counties that would provide counties containing at least 2500 acres of land held in trust by the US government for the benefit of Indians, to use for additional law enforcement and jail operation. These counties will no longer be entitled to up to \$101,000 from the state to put toward their law enforcement and jail budgets. LB 199 would also repeal the regulatory reporting and audit requirements associated with these funds.
