Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 618 amends section 75-331- establishment of the Transportation Network Company Regulation Cash Fund.

The fund was created pursuant to the Transportation Network Company Regulation Act which was enacted to provide a regulatory structure for the oversight of transportation network companies (UBER, Lyft, et.al) by the Nebraska Public Service Commission.

The designated uses of the fund are to regulate transportation network companies (TNC's) and to enforce the provisions of the TNC Regulatory Act and any rules and regulations adopted by the commission.

LB 618 proposes to expand the authorized use of the fund to include the carrying out of the policies of section 75-301 and for any costs associated with the administration of the fund.

Section 75-301 sets forth the policy of the legislature regarding the regulation of all motor carriers of passengers and household goods in Nebraska intrastate commerce.
