Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 624 allows law enforcement officers to pay a fee of \$25 to have their residential address withheld from the public by the county assessor and register of deeds, unless the address is requested in writing. The withholding period is 5 years, but is continually renewable for a \$25 fee for each 5 year period.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 330 eliminates the fee provisions from LB 624. This would allow an officer to obtain the protections under the bill by submitting the require application.
