Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 666 would alter Nebraska Criminal Code to regarding concealed weapons. It prevents any person, who is legally allowed to possess a firearm, from being charged with illegally carrying a concealed weapon if that firearm is being carried unloaded, and stored in a case.

LB 666 goes on to define a case as a hard or soft-sided container intended for firearm storage or transport.
