**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

Current law requires landowners to mow weeds to the middle of all public roads and drainage ditches running along their lands at least twice each year, before July 15 for the first time, and sometime in August for the second time. LB 584 would eliminate the requirement for twice a year mowing, but provides that this shall not restrict landowners, a county, or a township from management of (a) roadside vegetation on road shoulders, intersections, or entrances, (b) sight distance at any time of the year, or (c) snow control mowing as may be necessary annually. In addition, mowing of roadside ditches by a county or township would be prohibited before July 1.
