1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Military Code; to amend section 55-160,

- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating
- 3 to military leave of absence without loss of pay; and to repeal the

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 55-160, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 55-160 (1) All employees, including elected officials of the State 4 of Nebraska, or any political subdivision thereof, who are members of the 5 National Guard, Army Reserve, Naval Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, Air Force Reserve, and Coast Guard Reserve, shall be entitled to a military 6 7 leave of absence from their respective duties, without loss of pay, when employed with or without pay under the orders or authorization of 8 9 competent authority in the active service of the state or of the United States. Members who normally work or are normally scheduled to work one 10 hundred fifty-nine hours or more in three consecutive weeks and scheduled 11 to work twenty-four hour shifts shall receive a military leave of absence 12 of one hundred sixty-eight hours each calendar year. Members who normally 13 work or are normally scheduled to work one hundred twenty hours or more 14 but less than one hundred fifty-nine hours in three consecutive weeks 15 16 shall receive a military leave of absence of one hundred twenty hours 17 each calendar year. Members who normally work or are normally scheduled to work less than one hundred twenty hours in three consecutive weeks 18 19 shall receive a military leave of absence each calendar year equal to the number of hours they normally work or would normally be scheduled to 20 work, whichever is greater, in three consecutive weeks. Such military 21 22 leave of absence may be taken in hourly increments and shall be in addition to the regular annual leave of the persons named in this 23 24 section.

(2) When the Governor of this state declares that a state of emergency exists and any of the persons named in this section are ordered to active service of the state, a state of emergency leave of absence will be granted until such member is released from active service of the state by competent authority. A military leave of absence shall not be used during a state of emergency declared by the Governor. Other forms of leave may be granted. During a state of emergency leave of absence

because of the call of the Governor, any official or employee subject to this section shall receive his or her normal salary or compensation minus the state active duty base pay he or she receives in active service of the state. Governmental officers serving a term of office shall receive their compensation as provided by law.
