- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to aeronautics; to amend section 3-402,
 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016, and section 3-404,
 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017; to define a term; to change
 permit application and issuance requirements relating to regulation
 of certain structures by the Division of Aeronautics of the
 Department of Transportation; to provide a duty for the Nebraska
 National Guard as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
 the original sections.

1 Section 1. Section 3-402, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 3-402 As used in sections 3-401 to 3-409, unless the context
- 4 otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Structure means any manmade object which is built, constructed,
- 6 projected, or erected upon, from, and above the surface of the earth,
- 7 including, but not limited to, towers, antennas, buildings, wires,
- 8 cables, and chimneys;
- 9 (1) (2) Meteorological evaluation tower means an anchored structure,
- 10 including all guy wires and accessory facilities, on which one or more
- 11 meteorological instruments are mounted for the purpose of meteorological
- 12 data collection;
- 13 (2) (3) Obstruction means any structure which obstructs the air
- 14 space required for the flight of aircraft and in the landing and taking
- 15 off of aircraft at any airport or restricted landing area; and
- 16 (3) (4) Person means any public utility, public district, or other
- 17 governmental division or subdivision or any person, corporation,
- 18 partnership, or limited liability company; -
- 19 <u>(4) Structure means any manmade object which is built, constructed,</u>
- 20 projected, or erected upon, from, and above the surface of the earth,
- 21 including, but not limited to, towers, antennas, buildings, wires,
- 22 <u>cables</u>, and chimneys; and
- 23 (5) Terrain flight training area means an area established by the
- 24 Nebraska National Guard within which military and related flight training
- 25 is conducted using rotary-wing aircraft and which existed as of the
- 26 <u>effective date of this act.</u>
- 27 Sec. 2. Section 3-404, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is amended
- 28 to read:
- 29 3-404 (1) The application for the permit₇ required by section
- 30 $3-403_T$ shall be made in writing on forms prescribed by the Division of
- 31 Aeronautics of the Department of Transportation and shall contain or be

1 accompanied by details as to the location, construction, height, and

- 2 dimensions of the proposed structure, the nature of its intended use, and
- 3 such other information as the Director of Aeronautics may require. If the
- 4 proposed structure is proposed to be built inside the boundaries of or
- 5 within one thousand meters of the boundaries of any terrain flight
- 6 training area, the application for a permit shall be accompanied by a
- 7 written mitigation agreement between the applicant and the Nebraska
- 8 National Guard.
- 9 (2) Upon the filing of an such application, the director shall make
- 10 an investigation and an aeronautical study of such proposed construction
- 11 and its effect, if any, upon air navigation, and the health, welfare, and
- 12 safety of the public. <u>In making such investigation and aeronautical study</u>
- 13 and making his or her determination under this section, the director
- 14 <u>shall consider (a) the character of flying operations expected to be</u>
- 15 conducted in the area concerned, (b) the nature of the terrain, (c) the
- 16 character of the neighborhood, (d) the uses to which the property
- 17 concerned is devoted or adaptable, (e) the proximity to existing
- 18 <u>airports</u>, airways, control areas, and control zones, (f) the height of
- 19 <u>existing adjacent structures</u>, and (g) all the facts and circumstances
- 20 existing at the time of application.
- 21 (3) If the director, upon such investigation, <u>determines</u> shall
- 22 determine that such proposed structure will not constitute a hazard to
- 23 air navigation and will not interfere unduly with the public right of
- 24 freedom of transit in commerce through the air space affected thereby,
- 25 the director shall issue to the applicant a permit, required by section
- 26 3-403, authorizing the erection and construction of such structure,
- 27 subject to such conditions as to marking and lighting as the division may
- 28 prescribe by its rules and regulations, authorized by section 3-407. The
- 29 <u>director shall impose only such restrictions or requirements as may be</u>
- 30 reasonably necessary to effectuate sections 3-401 to 3-409. If the
- 31 director does not so determine, the director shall deny the application.

- 1 In making such investigation, aeronautical study, and determination, the
- 2 director shall consider (1) the character of flying operations expected
- 3 to be conducted in the area concerned, (2) the nature of the terrain, (3)
- 4 the character of the neighborhood, (4) the uses to which the property
- 5 concerned is devoted or adaptable, (5) the proximity to existing
- 6 airports, airways, control areas, and control zones, (6) the height of
- 7 existing adjacent structures, and (7) all the facts and circumstances
- 8 existing. The director shall impose only such restrictions or
- 9 requirements as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the purposes of
- 10 sections 3-401 to 3-409.
- 11 (4) On or before August 1, 2018, the Nebraska National Guard shall
- 12 provide the Division of Aeronautics of the Department of Transportation a
- 13 <u>description of the boundaries of the terrain flight training areas by</u>
- 14 metes and bounds or an official map that shows the boundaries of the
- 15 terrain flight training areas. The description or map shall be used by
- 16 the division in its management of the airspace of the State of Nebraska
- 17 pursuant to sections 3-401 to 3-409.
