- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to registration of voters; to amend section
- 2 32-206, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 32-304,
- 3 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017; to provide a deadline for
- 4 electronic voter registration; to harmonize provisions; and to
- 5 repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 32-206, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 32-206 (1) The Secretary of State shall publish an official election
- 4 calendar by November 1 prior to the statewide primary election. Such
- 5 calendar, to be approved as to form by the Attorney General, shall set
- 6 forth the various election deadline dates and other pertinent data as
- 7 determined by the Secretary of State. The official election calendar
- 8 shall be merely a quideline and shall in no way legally bind the
- 9 Secretary of State or the Attorney General.
- 10 (2) The Secretary of State shall deliver a copy of the official
- 11 election calendar to the state party headquarters of each recognized
- 12 political party within ten days after publication under subsection (1) of
- 13 this section.
- 14 (3) Except as provided in sections 32-302, 32-304, and 32-306, any
- 15 filing or other act required to be performed by a specified day shall be
- 16 performed by 5 p.m. of such day, except that if such day falls upon a
- 17 Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, performance shall be required on the
- 18 next business day.
- 19 Sec. 2. Section 32-304, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 32-304 (1) The Secretary of State in conjunction with the Department
- 22 of Motor Vehicles shall, on or before September 1, 2015, develop and
- 23 implement a registration application process which may be used statewide
- 24 to register to vote and update voter registration records electronically
- 25 using the Secretary of State's web site. An applicant who has a valid
- 26 Nebraska motor vehicle operator's license or state identification card
- 27 may use the application process to register to vote or to update his or
- 28 her voter registration record with changes in his or her personal
- 29 information or other information related to his or her eligibility to
- 30 vote. For each electronic application, the Secretary of State shall
- 31 obtain a copy of the electronic representation of the applicant's

- 1 signature from the Department of Motor Vehicles' records of his or her
- 2 motor vehicle operator's license or state identification card for
- 3 purposes of voter registration.
- 4 (2) The application shall contain substantially all the information
- 5 provided in section 32-312 and the following informational statements:
- 6 (a) An applicant who submits this application electronically is
- 7 affirming that the information in the application is true. Any applicant
- 8 who submits this application electronically knowing that any of the
- 9 information in the application is false shall be guilty of a Class IV
- 10 felony under section 32-1502 of the statutes of Nebraska. The penalty for
- 11 a Class IV felony is up to two years imprisonment and twelve months post-
- 12 release supervision, a fine of up to ten thousand dollars, or both;
- 13 (b) An applicant who submits this application electronically is
- 14 agreeing to the use of his or her signature from the Department of Motor
- 15 Vehicles' records of his or her motor vehicle operator's license or state
- 16 identification card for purposes of voter registration;
- 17 (c) To vote at the polling place on election day, the completed
- 18 application must be submitted on or before the third Friday before the
- 19 election and prior to midnight on such Friday; and
- 20 (d) The election commissioner or county clerk will, upon receipt of
- 21 the application for registration, send an acknowledgment of registration
- 22 to the applicant indicating whether the application is proper or not.
- 23 Sec. 3. Original section 32-206, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 24 Nebraska, and section 32-304, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, are
- 25 repealed.
