- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Tax Equity and Educational
- 2 Opportunities Support Act; to amend section 79-1022, Revised
- 3 Statutes Supplement, 2017; to provide for a minimum amount of state
- 4 aid to be distributed to each local system; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 79-1022, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-1022 (1)(a) (1) on or before June 1, 2017, and on or before
- 4 March 1 of each year thereafter, for each ensuing fiscal year, the
- 5 department shall determine the amounts to be distributed to each local
- 6 system and each district for the ensuing school fiscal year pursuant to
- 7 the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act and shall
- 8 certify the amounts to the Director of Administrative Services, the
- 9 Auditor of Public Accounts, each learning community for school fiscal
- 10 years prior to school fiscal year 2017-18, and each district.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of the act, for the 2019-20
- 12 school fiscal year and each school fiscal year thereafter, the amount to
- 13 be distributed to each local system under the act and certified pursuant
- 14 <u>to this section shall be the greater of twenty-five percent of the basic</u>
- 15 <u>funding calculated for the school districts in such local system for such</u>
- 16 school fiscal year or the total amount calculated pursuant to the
- 17 remainder of the act.
- 18 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the amount to be
- 19 distributed to each district from the amount certified for a local system
- 20 shall be proportional based on the formula students attributed to each
- 21 district in the local system. For school fiscal years prior to school
- 22 fiscal year 2017-18, the amount to be distributed to each district that
- 23 is a member of a learning community from the amount certified for the
- 24 local system shall be proportional based on the formula needs calculated
- 25 for each district in the local system.
- 26 (d) On or before June 1, 2017, and on or before March 1 of each year
- 27 thereafter, for each ensuing fiscal year, the department shall report the
- 28 necessary funding level for the ensuing school fiscal year to the
- 29 Governor, the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature, and the
- 30 Education Committee of the Legislature. The report submitted to the
- 31 committees of the Legislature shall be submitted electronically.

- 1 (e) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, certified state
- 2 aid amounts, including adjustments pursuant to section 79-1065.02, shall
- 3 be shown as budgeted non-property-tax receipts and deducted prior to
- 4 calculating the property tax request in the district's general fund
- 5 budget statement as provided to the Auditor of Public Accounts pursuant
- 6 to section 79-1024.
- 7 (2) Except as provided in this subsection, subsection (8) of section
- 8 79-1016, and sections 79-1005, 79-1033, and 79-1065.02, the amounts
- 9 certified pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed
- 10 in ten as nearly as possible equal payments on the last business day of
- 11 each month beginning in September of each ensuing school fiscal year and
- 12 ending in June of the following year, except that when a school district
- is to receive a monthly payment of less than one thousand dollars, such
- 14 payment shall be one lump-sum payment on the last business day of
- 15 December during the ensuing school fiscal year.
