- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-760.06,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to require annual
- 3 reporting of performance scores and classification levels; to
- 4 provide a penalty; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 79-760.06, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 79-760.06 (1) On or before August 1, 2012, the State Board of
- 4 Education shall establish an accountability system to be used to measure
- 5 the performance of individual public schools and school districts. The
- 6 accountability system shall combine multiple indicators, including, but
- 7 not limited to, graduation rates, student growth and student improvement
- 8 on the assessment instruments provided in section 79-760.03, and other
- 9 indicators of the performance of public schools and school districts as
- 10 established by the state board.
- 11 (2) Beginning with the reporting of data from school year 2014-15,
- 12 the indicators selected by the state board for the accountability system
- 13 shall be combined <u>annually</u> into a school performance score and district
- 14 performance score. The state board shall establish levels of performance
- 15 based upon school performance scores and district performance scores in
- 16 order to annually classify and report the performance of public schools
- 17 and school districts beginning with the reporting of data from school
- 18 year 2014-15. The department shall classify and report the performance of
- 19 public schools and school districts annually on or before December 31 of
- 20 <u>each calendar year.</u>
- 21 (3) The state board shall designate priority schools based on such
- 22 classification. Schools designated as priority schools shall be at the
- 23 lowest performance level at the time of the initial priority school
- 24 designation. Schools designated as priority schools shall remain priority
- 25 schools until such designation is removed by the state board. No more
- 26 than three schools may have a priority school designation at one time.
- 27 Schools designated as priority schools shall be subject to the
- 28 requirements of section 79-760.07. Progress plans for the initial schools
- 29 designated as priority schools shall be approved by the state board no
- 30 later than August 15, 2016. The State Department of Education shall
- 31 annually report the performance level of individual public schools and
