- 2 Nebraska Economic Development Advisory Committee; to provide duties;
- and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature finds and declares that:

2 (a) Economic development is vitally important for the well-being of

- 3 the state;
- 4 (b) Because there is no standing committee specifically dedicated to
- 5 <u>economic development</u>, <u>legislation addressing economic development is</u>
- 6 referenced to various standing committees; and
- 7 <u>(c) The Legislature and the State of Nebraska would benefit from a</u>
- 8 <u>more coordinated approach to legislation addressing economic development.</u>
- 9 (2) The Nebraska Economic Development Advisory Committee is created.
- 10 The committee shall gather input on issues pertaining to economic
- 11 development and discuss proactive approaches on economic development. The
- 12 <u>committee shall monitor and guide analysis and policy development in all</u>
- 13 <u>aspects of economic development in Nebraska. The committee shall also</u>
- 14 <u>discuss long-range strategic plans to improve economic development within</u>
- 15 the state.
- 16 (3) The Nebraska Economic Development Advisory Committee shall be
- 17 composed of three nonvoting members of the Legislature appointed by the
- 18 Executive Board of the Legislative Council, one from each congressional
- 19 district, and the following six nonvoting, ex officio members: The
- 20 Director of Economic Development or his or her designee, the Commissioner
- 21 of Labor or his or her designee, the chairperson of the Appropriations
- 22 Committee of the Legislature or his or her designee, the chairperson of
- 23 the Business and Labor Committee of the Legislature or his or her
- 24 designee, the chairperson of the Revenue Committee of the Legislature or
- 25 his or her designee, and the chairperson of the Urban Affairs Committee
- 26 of the Legislature or his or her designee. The committee members shall
- 27 <u>choose a chairperson and vice-chairperson from among the committee</u>
- 28 members.
- 29 (4)(a) The Nebraska Economic Development Advisory Committee shall
- 30 meet on or before June 15, 2017, and on or before each June 15
- 31 <u>thereafter</u>.

- 1 (b) Following the meeting required by subdivision (4)(a) of this
- 2 <u>section</u>, the committee shall meet not less than once every three months,
- 3 but shall not be required to meet while the Legislature is in session.
- 4 (c) Meetings of the committee shall be called by the chairperson.
- 5 (d) The committee may ask other persons or entities to attend its
- 6 <u>meetings or present information at such meetings.</u>
- 7 (5) This section shall terminate on January 1, 2024.
- 8 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 9 passed and approved according to law.
