 39-1411 and 39-1412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
 provisions relating to carrying capacity and weight limits of
 bridges; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 39-1411, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 39-1411 The county highway superintendent or some other qualified person designated by the county board shall keep in his or her office a 4 5 road record which shall include a record of the proceedings in regard to the laying out, establishing, changing, or discontinuing of all roads in 6 7 the county hereafter established, changed, or discontinued, and a record of the cost and maintenance of all such roads. Such person shall record 8 9 in the bridge record, a record of all county bridges and culverts showing number, location, and description of each, and a record of the cost of 10 construction and maintenance of all such bridges and culverts. If the 11 carrying capacity or weight limit of any bridge is less than the limits 12 set forth in subsections (2), (3), and (4) of section 60-6,294, the 13 14 county Such person shall cause to be firmly posted or attached upon such each bridge in a conspicuous place at each end thereof a board or metal 15 sign showing the carrying capacity or weight which the bridge will safely 16 17 carry or bear.

18 Sec. 2. Section 39-1412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 19 amended to read:

39-1412 Any person driving across or going upon any county bridge 20 with a greater weight than the limits set forth in subsections (2), (3), 21 22 and (4) of section 60-6,294 or the carrying capacity or weight posted or attached thereupon as provided in section 39-1411, shall recover no 23 24 damages from the county because of any accident or injury which may 25 happen to him upon such bridge and such . Such person shall, for entering upon any such bridge with a greater weight than the carrying capacity or 26 27 weight posted thereupon as provided in section $39-1411_7$ be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. 28

Sec. 3. Original sections 39-1411 and 39-1412, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
